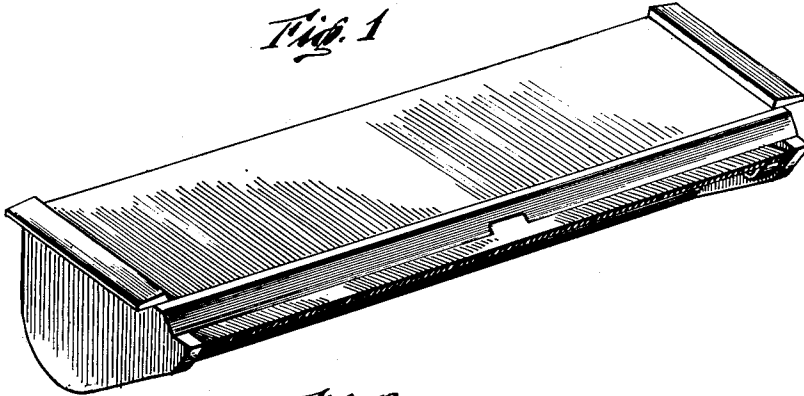

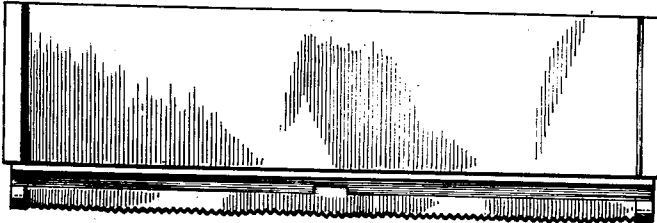

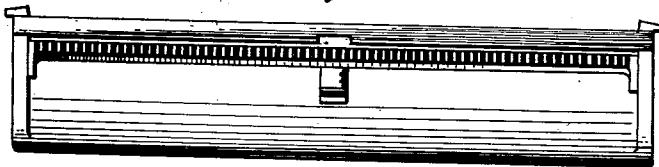

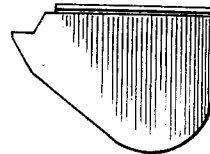
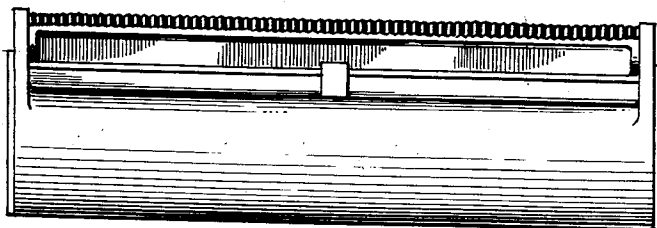

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Peter De Grace, a citizen of the United States of America, residing at West Gardena, in the county of Los Angeles and State of California, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Wax Paper Dispenser, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

In the drawing

Fig. 1 is a perspective view of a wax paper dispenser, showing my new design;

Fig. 2 is a top plan view;

Fig. 3 is a front elevation view;

Fig. 4 is a side elevation view of Fig. 3; and

Fig. 5 is a bottom view.
