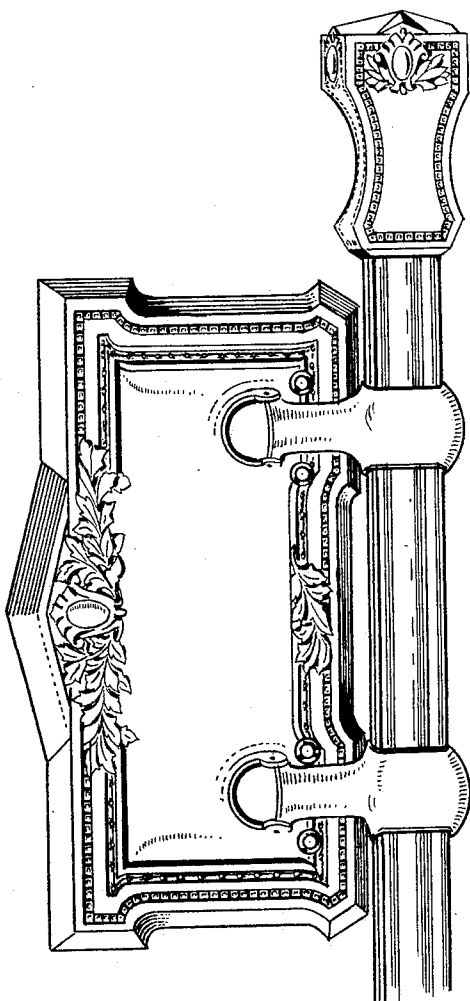

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, CHARLES BLESCH, a citizen of the United States, residing at Newport, in the county of Campbell and State of Kentucky, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Burial-Casket Handles, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

My new, original and ornamental design for a burial-casket handle is shown in the

accompanying drawing, in which, the figure is a front elevation of a burial-casket handle, showing my new design, one end of the handle-bar being broken away.

The ornamental design for a burial-casket handle, substantially as shown.
