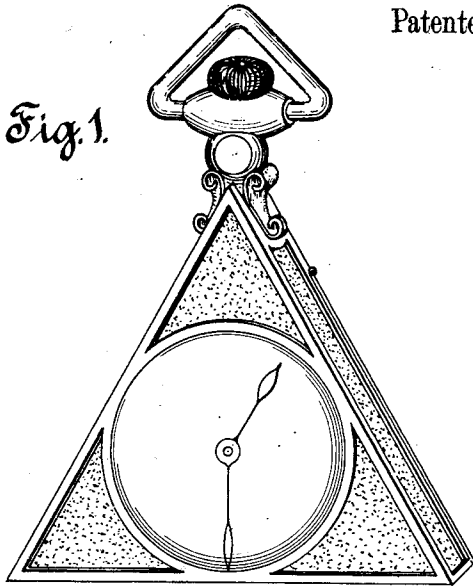
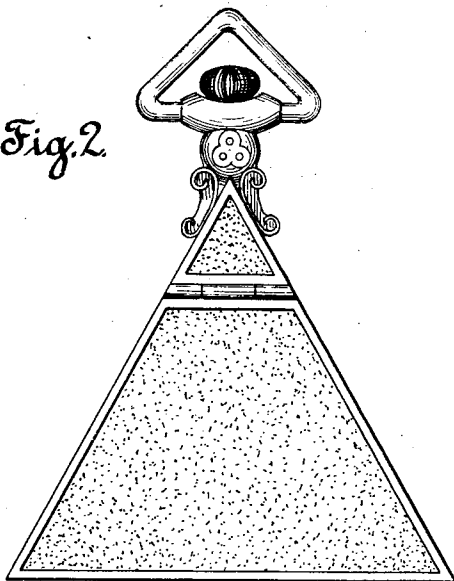

DESIGN FOR A WATCHCASE.

Application filed June 13, 1922. Serial No. 2,653. Term of patent 14 years.

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, GEORGE J. KELLER, a citizen of the United States, residing in the city of Newark, in the county of Essex and State of New Jersey, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Watchcase, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawings, forming a part thereof.
