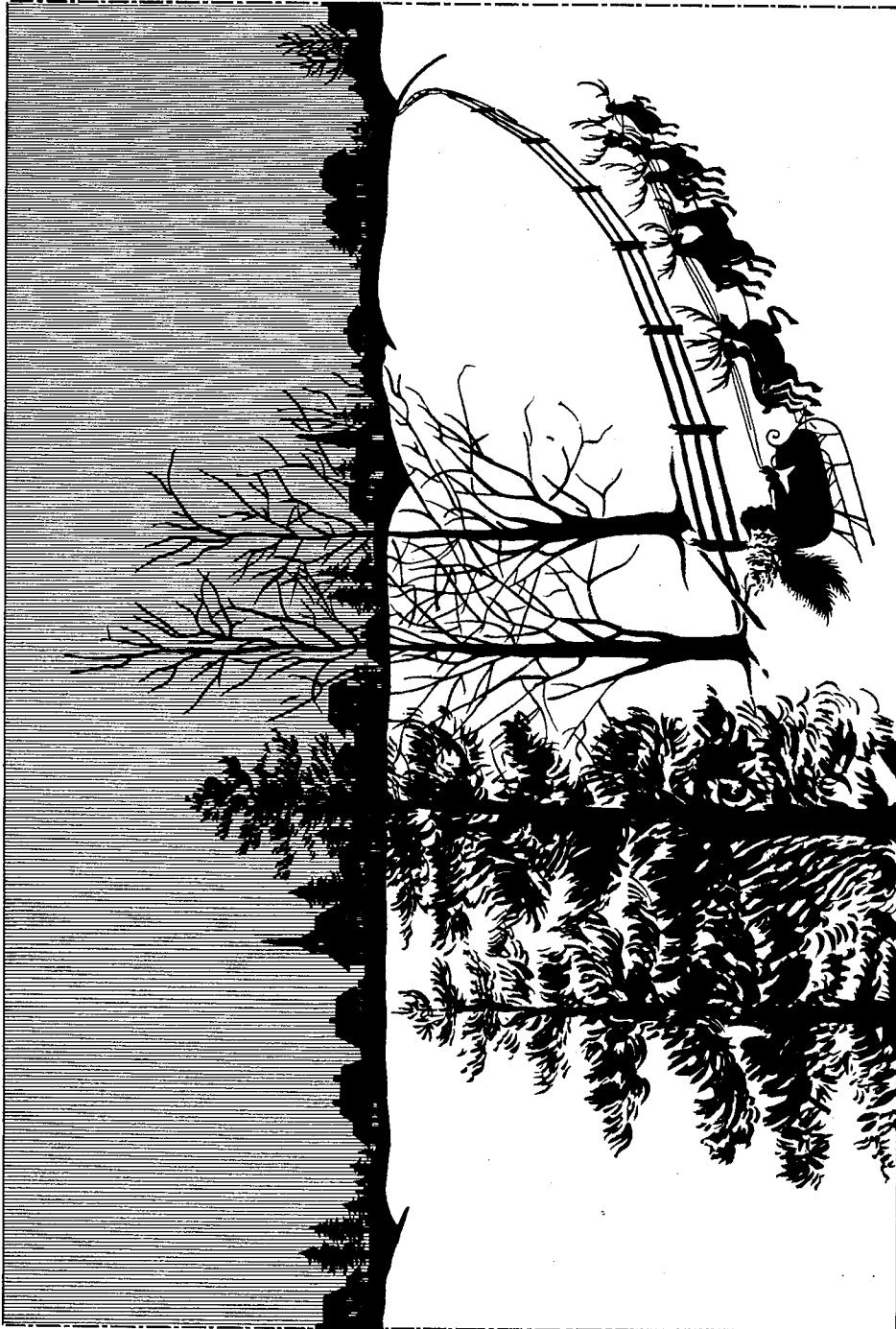

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, CLARA L. MEAD, a citizen of the United States, residing at Rahway, in the county of Union and State of New Jersey, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Paper Sheet or Similar Article, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

The figure is a plan view of a paper sheet showing my new design.

The design is a snow covered landscape with trees in the foreground and a road, partially delimited as by a fence, along

which "Santa Claus" is driving his sleigh drawn by reindeers. In the background silhouetted against a sky of contrasted color with the snow, preferably red as indicated, are the houses, spires and trees of a village.

I claim:

The ornamental design for a paper sheet or similar article, substantially as shown and described.
