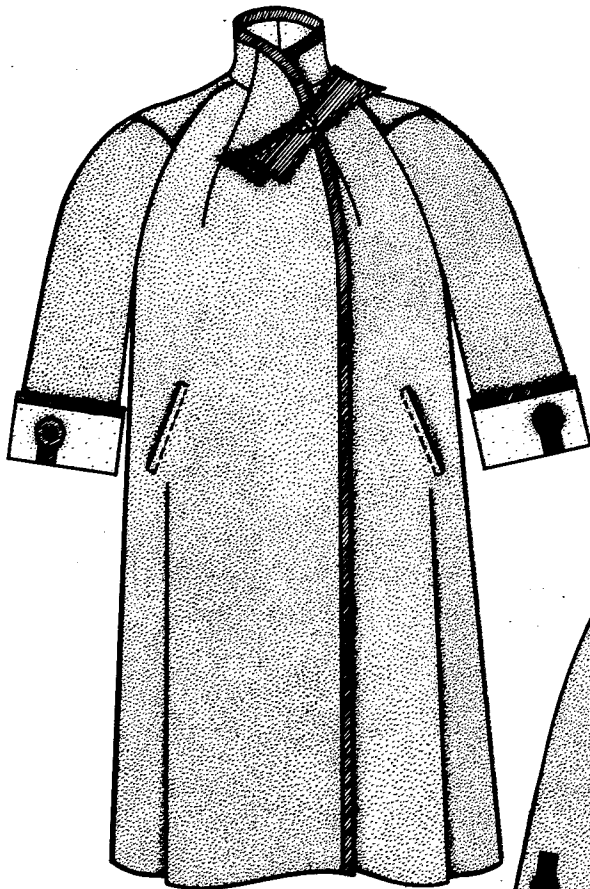

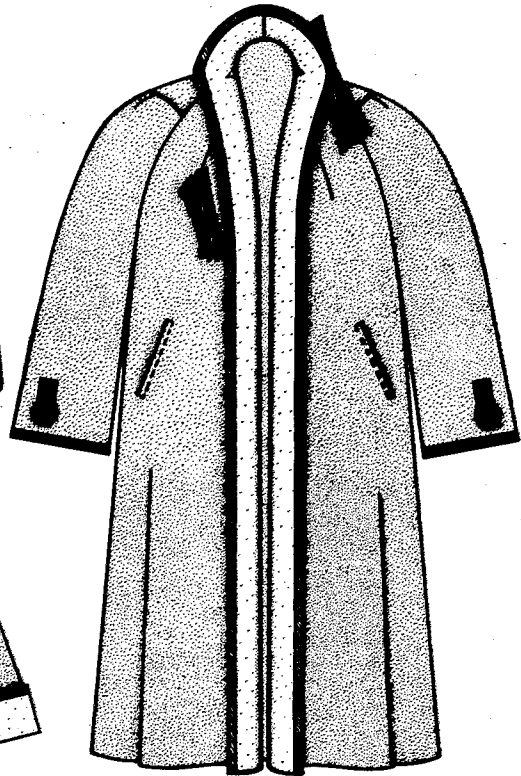

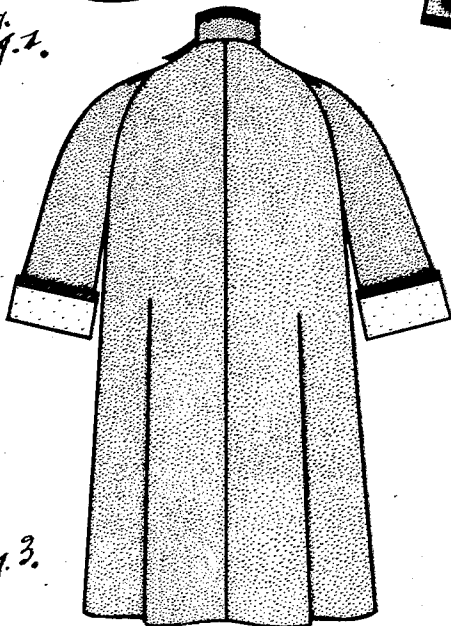

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, David Bellsey, a citizen of the United States of America, residing in New York, county of New York, and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Lady's Coat, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

Fig. 1 is a front view of a lady's coat showing my new design.

Fig. 2 is a front view illustrating the front and collar portions in open position and the cuff turned down.

Fig. 3 is a rear view of the coat as shown in Fig. 1.
