







FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof.

FIG. 3 is a cross-sectional view, taken along line III--III of FIG. 2.

FIG. 4 is a right side, top and front perspective view of a clothes dryer showing another embodiment of my new design.

FIG. 5 is a front elevational view thereof.

FIG. 6 is a cross-sectional view taken along line VI--VI of FIG. 5.

That side of the clothes dryer not shown is substantially the same as the side which is shown and the back is substantially plain.
