

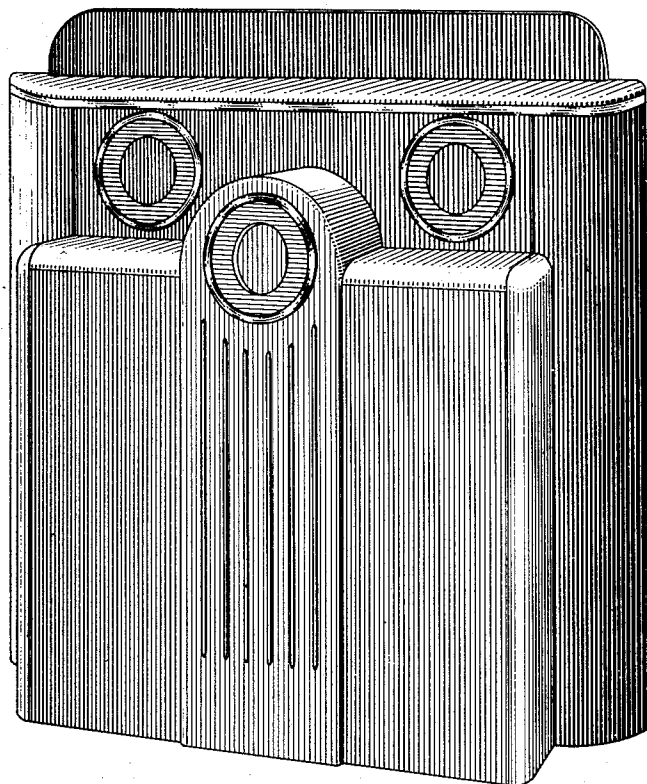

## DESIGN FOR A LUBRICATOR CABINET

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, Thomas L. Hand, a citizen of the United States and resident of Cincinnati, in the county of Hamilton and State of Ohio, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Lubricator Cabinet, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.
