The ornamental design for a pen band, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of the pen band showing my new design;  
FIG. 2 is a rear elevation view of FIG. 1;  
FIG. 3 is a rear elevation view of FIG. 1;  
FIG. 4 is a left side elevation view of FIG. 1; and,  
FIG. 5 is a top plan view of FIG. 1; the bottom plan view being a mirror image of the top plan view.  
The pen in broken lines is included for the purpose of showing a feature in the environment that forms no part of the claimed design.









