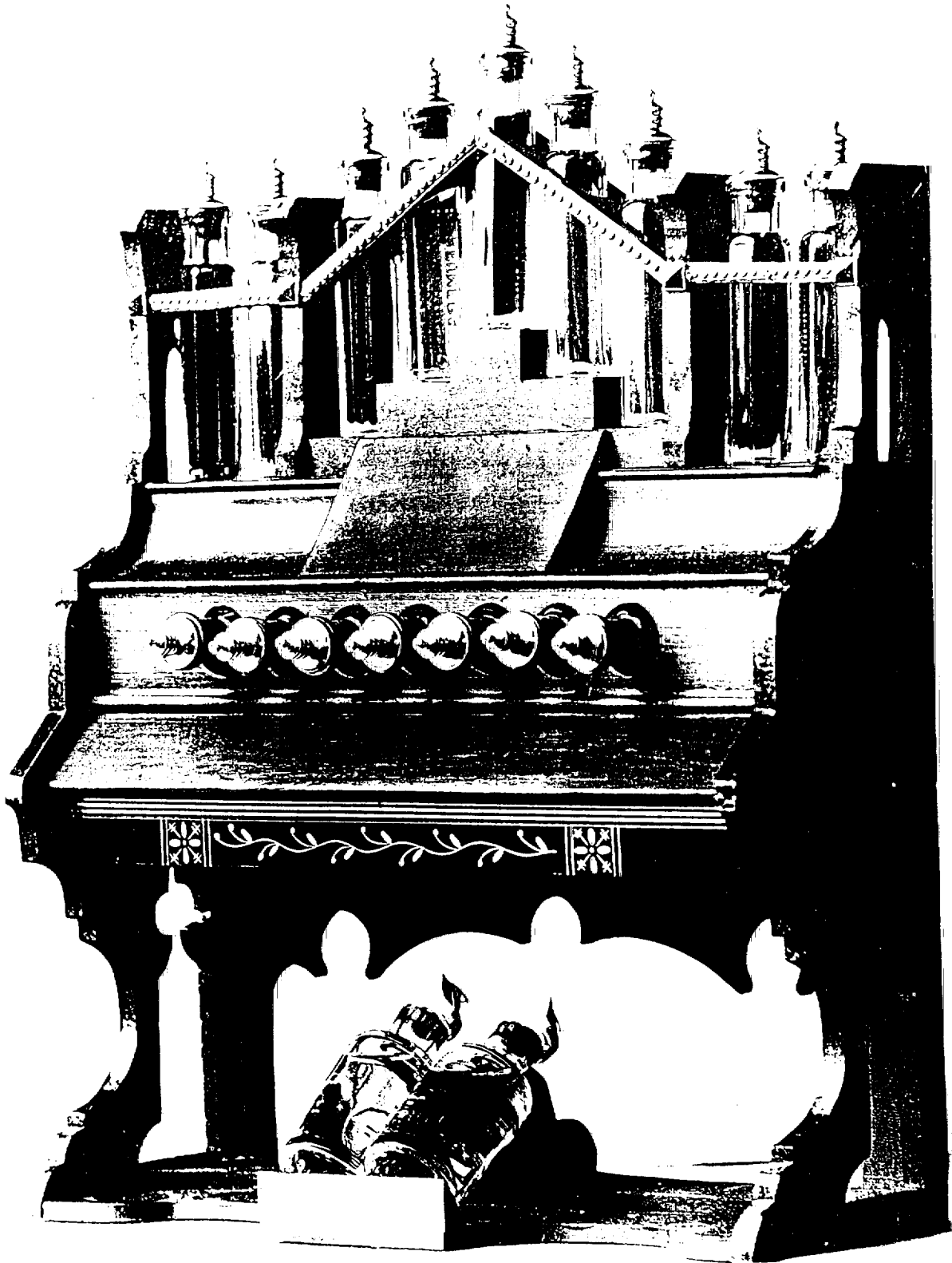

DESIGN FOR A BOTTLE-STAND.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, FREDERICK A. OHRENSCHALL, a citizen of the United States, residing at the city of Baltimore, in the State of Maryland, have invented and produced a new and original Design for a Bottle-Stand, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying photograph, forming part thereof.

10 Said photograph sufficiently represents my design, which is a bottle-stand in the general form of a church-organ, with a series of bottle-

shaped pipes, and also bottle shaped stops and pedals.

I claim—

15 The design for a bottle-stand herein shown and described, the same consisting of the representation of a church-organ, with a series of bottle-shaped pipes, and also bottle-shaped stops and pedals.
