

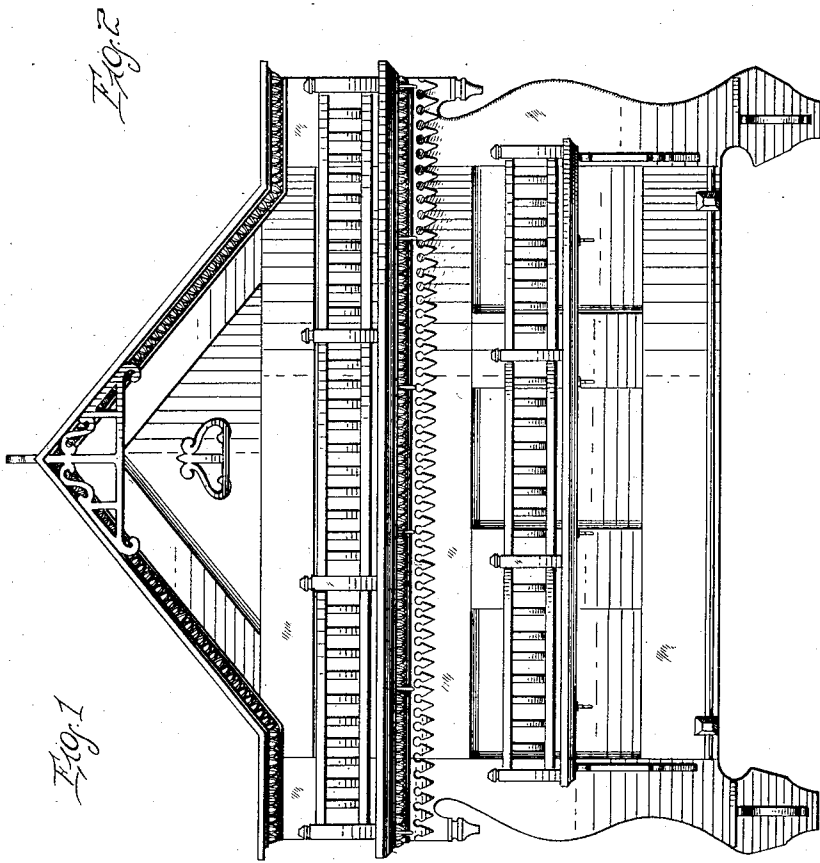
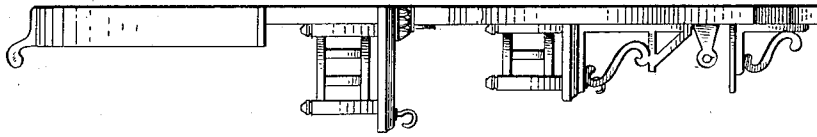

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, GOTTFRIED SCHICK, a citizen of the United States, residing at Tampa, in the county of Marion and State of Kansas, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Plate-Rack, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.
