DESIGN FOR TYPE.

SPECIFICATION forming part of Design No. 16,680, dated May 11, 1886.

Application filed April 3, 1886. Serial No. 197,716. Term of patent 7 years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, JAMES M. CONNER, of the city, county, and State of New York, have invented and produced a new and original
5 Design for a Font of Printing-Type, of which the following is a specification.

The nature of my design is clearly shown in the accompanying typographic impression, to which reference is made; and it consists of
10 an extended letter ornamented upon the right and below by a light line. The top and bottom portions of the letters have the inclined sides, as shown.

The central portions of the B, D, P, and R, upon the right hand, are extended beyond the
15 top and bottom lines of the letter in each case, and consist of the short inclined lines connected upon the right by a short vertical line, and this characteristic is found in the C and
20 G upon the left hand, and in the O and Q upon the right hand and left hand. The A, B, D, E, F, H, I, J, K, L, M, N, P, R, T, U, V, W, X, Y, and Z are shaded by the light line at the
upper left-hand portion.

25 The character of the design is preserved in the symbol &, the punctuation-marks, pound-sterling mark, and numerals.

Having now described my invention, I claim as new—

The design for a font of printing-type, as
30 shown, the same consisting of an extended letter ornamented upon the right and below by a light line, the top and bottom portions of the letters having the inclined sides, as shown,
35 the central portions of the B, D, P, and R, upon the right hand, being extended beyond the top and bottom lines of the letter in each case, and consisting of the short inclined lines connected upon the right by a short vertical line,
40 and this characteristic being found in the C and G upon the left hand, and in the O and Q upon the right hand and left hand, the A, B, D, E, F, H, I, J, K, L, M, N, P, R, T, U, V, W, X, Y, and Z shaded by the light line at the upper
45 left-hand portion, and the character of the design preserved in the symbol &, the punctuation-marks, pound-sterling mark, and the numerals.
