

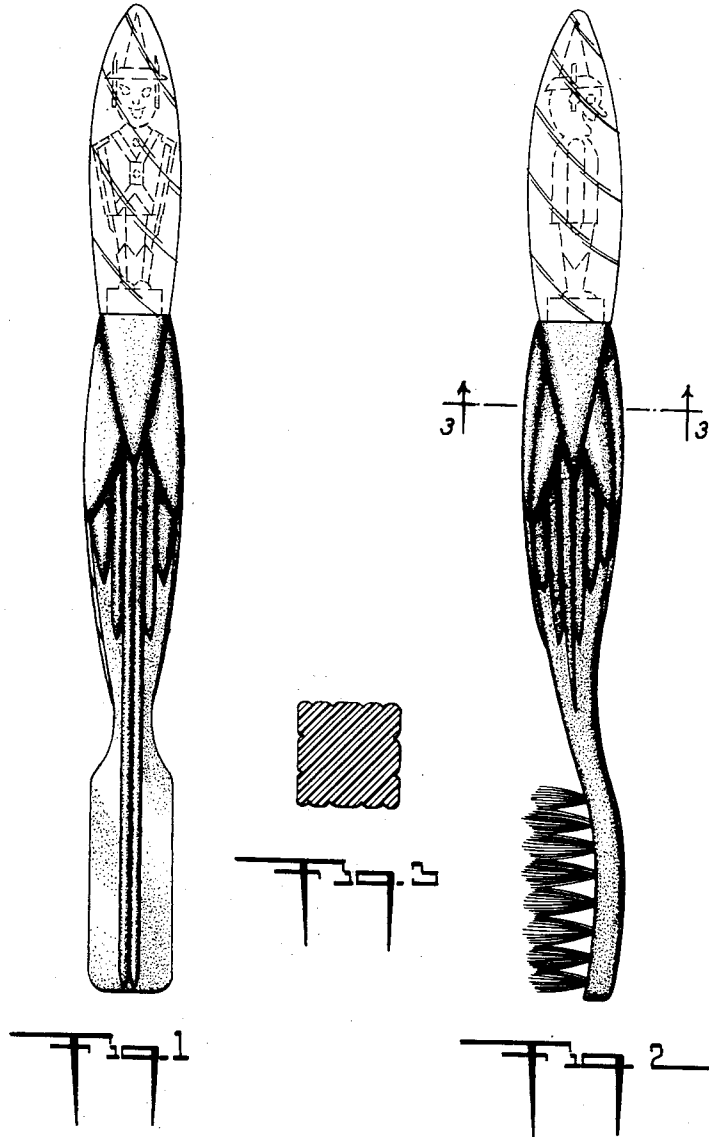

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Christy M. Del Mas, a citizen of the United States of America, residing at city, county, and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Toothbrush, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

Figure 1 is a top plan view of a toothbrush embodying my new design;

Figure 2 is a side elevational view thereof; and

Figure 3 is a cross sectional view through the handle of the brush, as seen on the line 3—3 of Figure 2.

The characteristic features of my design are shown by full lines in the drawing.
