

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Christy M. Del Mas, a citizen of the United States of America, residing at city, county, and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Toothbrush, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

Figure 1 is a top plan view of a toothbrush embodying my new design;

Figure 2 is a side elevational view thereof; and Figure 3 is a cross sectional view through the handle of the brush, as seen on the line **3—3** of Figure 2. The characteristic features of my design are shown by full lines in the drawing. I claim:

The ornamental design for a toothbrush, as shown and described.
