

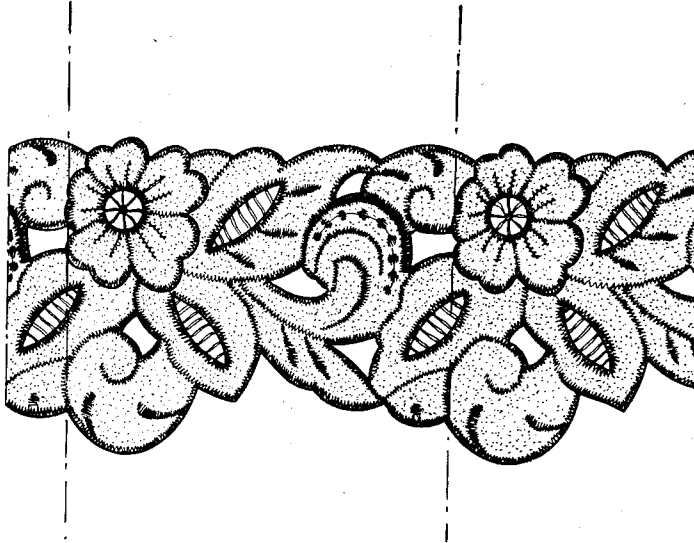

DESIGN FOR AN EMBROIDERED LACE FABRIC

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Jack Wiener, a citizen of the United States of America, residing in New York city, county of New York, and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for an Embroidered Lace Fabric, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

The figure on the drawing is a plan view of

an embroidered lace fabric showing my new design. The design unit is contained between the dot and dash lines, which unit is repeated in regular succession as indicated by the extensions beyond the unit boundaries.

I claim:

The ornamental design for an embroidered lace fabric, substantially as shown and described.
