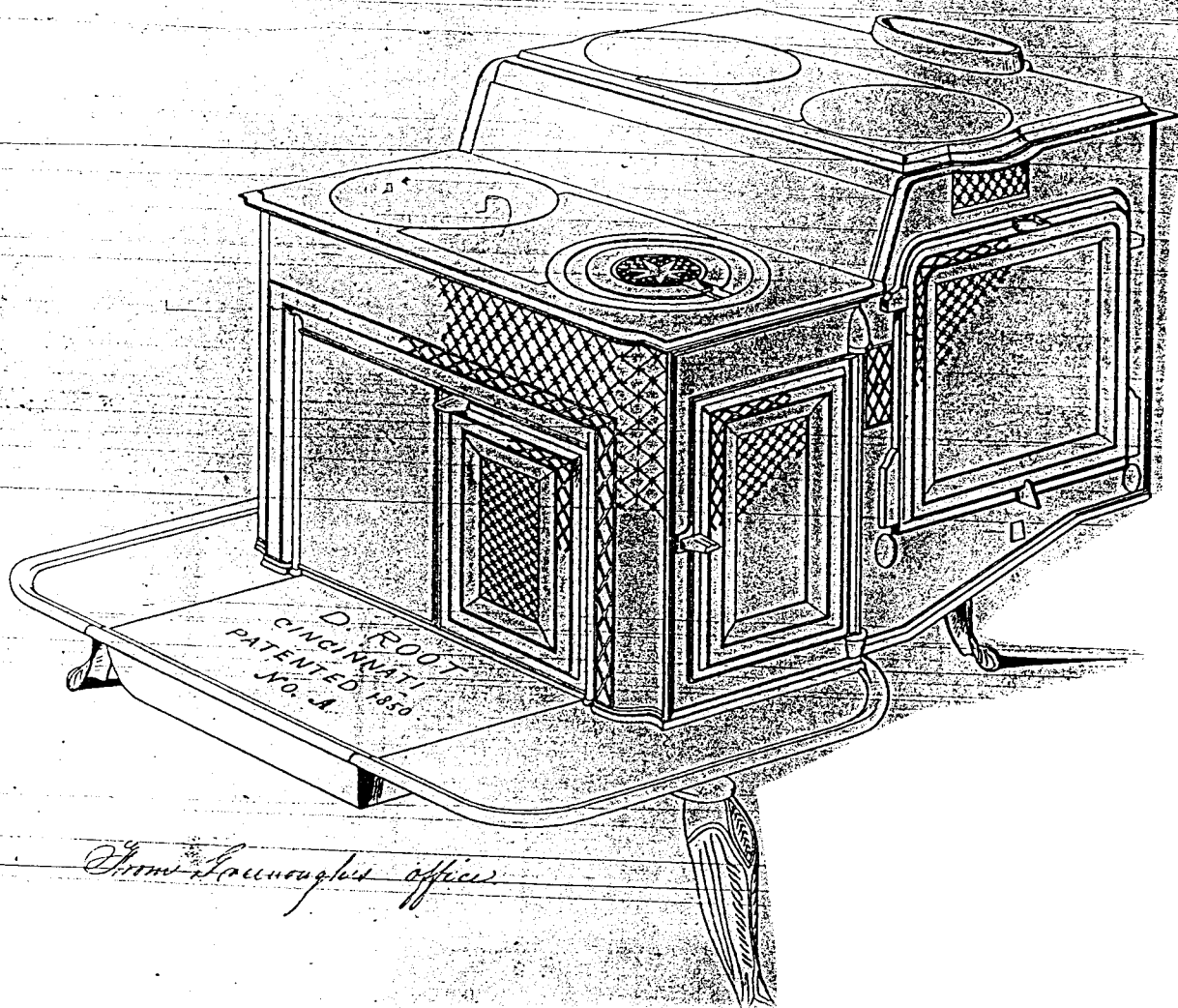

Letters Patent No. 284. Dated May 21. 1850.

The Schedule referred to in these Letters Patent and making part of the same.

To all to whom these presents shall come:

Be it known that D. Root of Cincinnati in the County of Hamilton and State of Ohio have invented a certain Design for Cooking Stoves and that the following is a full, clear, and exact description of the principle or character which distinguishes it from all other things before known, and of the usual manner of making, modifying, and using the same, reference being had to the accompanying Perspective Drawing of the Stove.

The circular covers for the holes have an indented star and net pattern on them. The doors are paneled and ornamented with net work pattern having a border of the same with mouldings. The top plate has a moulded edge, and that part over the oven is raised higher than that over the fire. The ash pit cover has the words "D. Root. Cincinnati. Patented 1850. No A" cast on it. The stove is supported on three curved and swelled legs.

Having thus fully described and illustrated my design for cooking stoves. What I claim as new and for which I desire to obtain Letters Patent, is the particular form and design as herein described and illustrated.
