

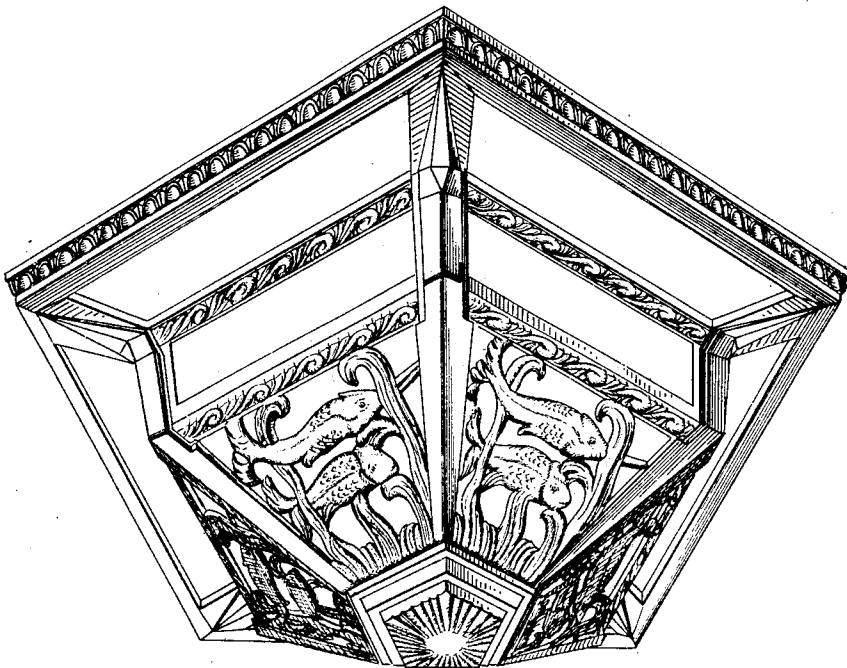

DESIGN FOR A CANOPY FOR LIGHTING FIXTURES OR SIMILAR ARTICLES

Application filed January 8, 1930. Serial No. 34,053. Term of patent $3\frac{1}{2}$ years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, OTTO HOFFMANN, a citizen of Germany, residing at Woodhaven, Long Island, in the county of Queens, State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Canopy for Lighting Fixtures or Similar Articles, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

The figure is a perspective view of a can-

opy for lighting fixtures, or similar articles showing my new design. The contour of the article is pentagonal and has the same general effect on all of its sides as the two sides shown in the present view.

I claim:

The ornamental design for a canopy for lighting fixtures, or similar articles as shown and described.
