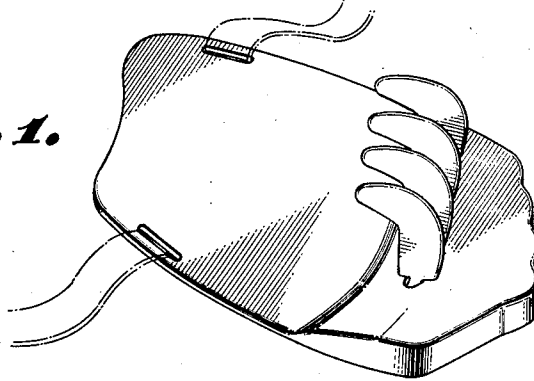

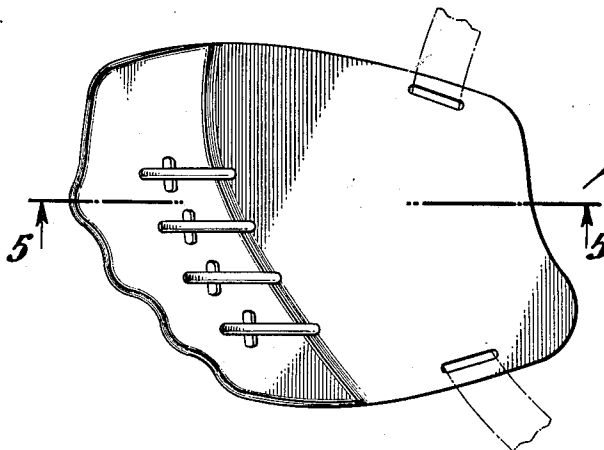

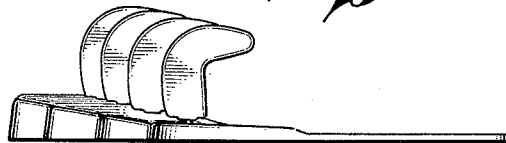
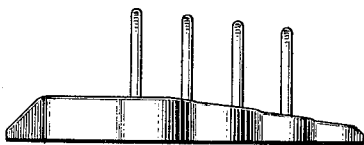

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Woodrow W. Pearce, a citizen of the United States, residing in Los Angeles, county of Los Angeles, State of California, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Pedicure Apparatus or Similar Article, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

Figure 1 is a perspective view of a pedicure apparatus showing my new design;

Figure 2 is a plan view;

Figure 3 is a side view;

Figure 4 is an end view;

Figure 5 is a sectional view on line 5—5 of Figure 2.

The broken line illustration of the strap is shown fragmentarily for convenience of illus-

tration and the dominant features of the design reside in the portion shown in full lines.

The ornamental design for a pedicure apparatus or similar article, as shown and described.
