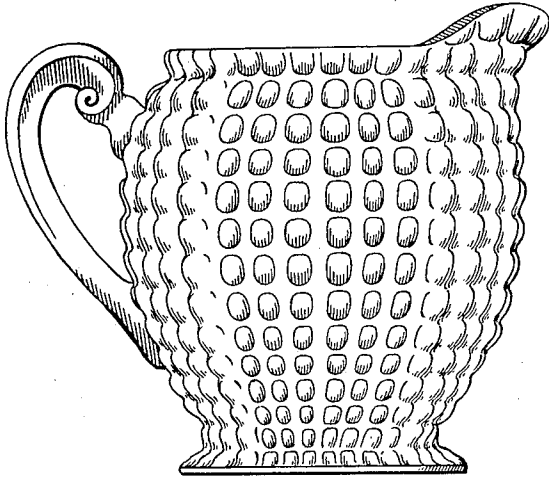

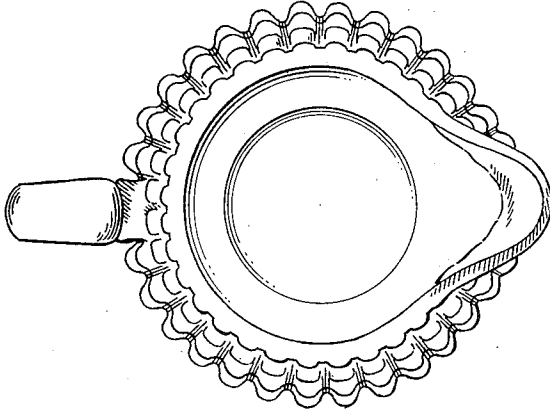

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Charles Kaiser, a citizen of the United States, and a resident of Great Neck, county of Nassau, and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Creamer, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part hereof.
