DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevation view of a handbag showing my new design;

FIG. 3 is a left side view thereof;

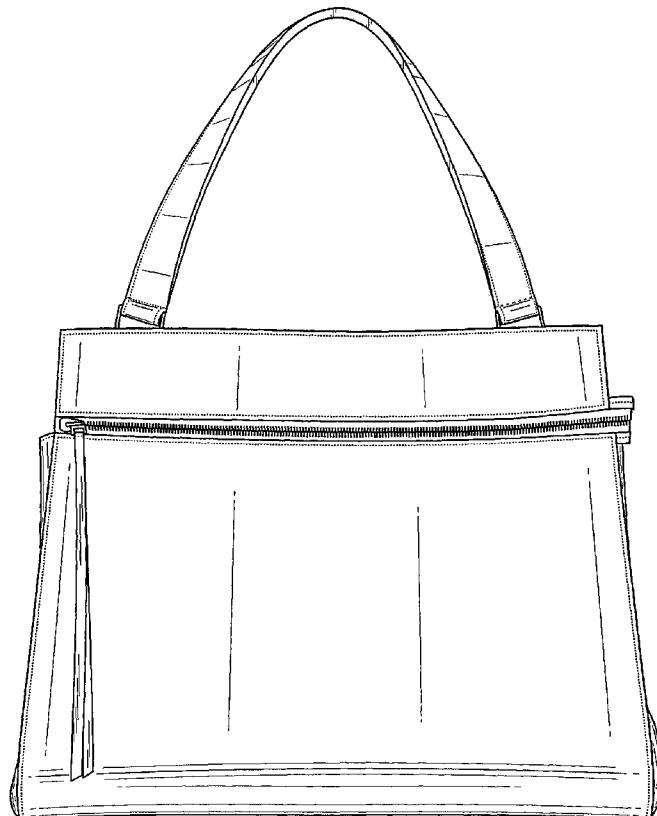
FIG. 4 is a rear elevation view thereof;

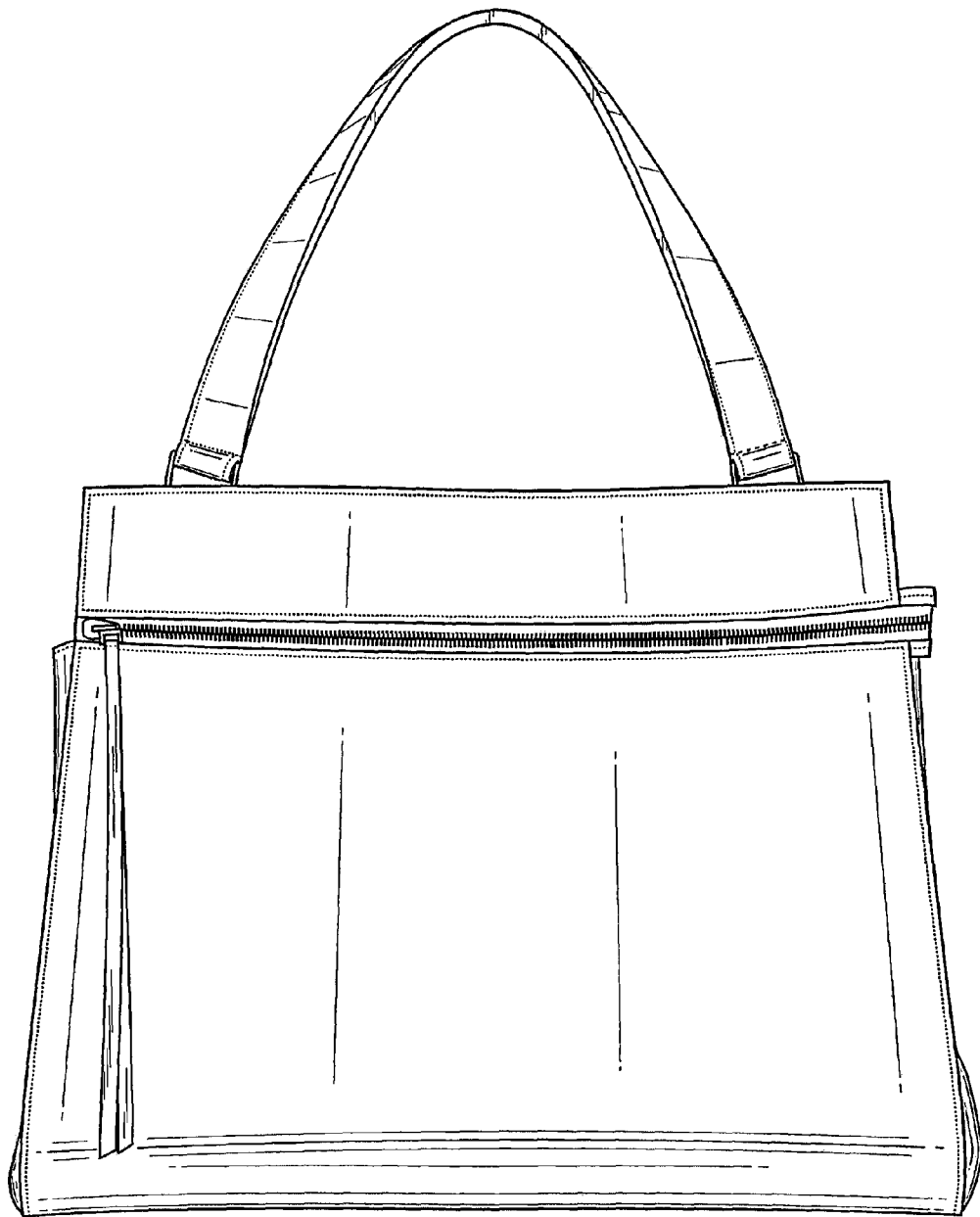

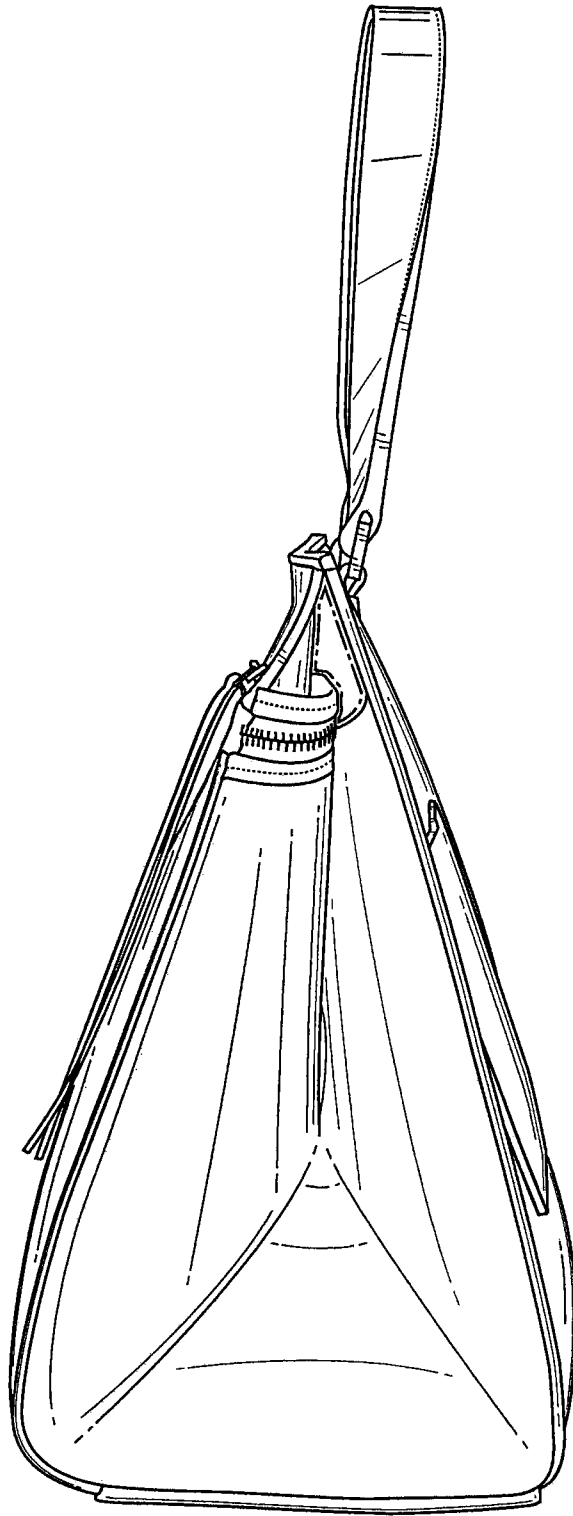

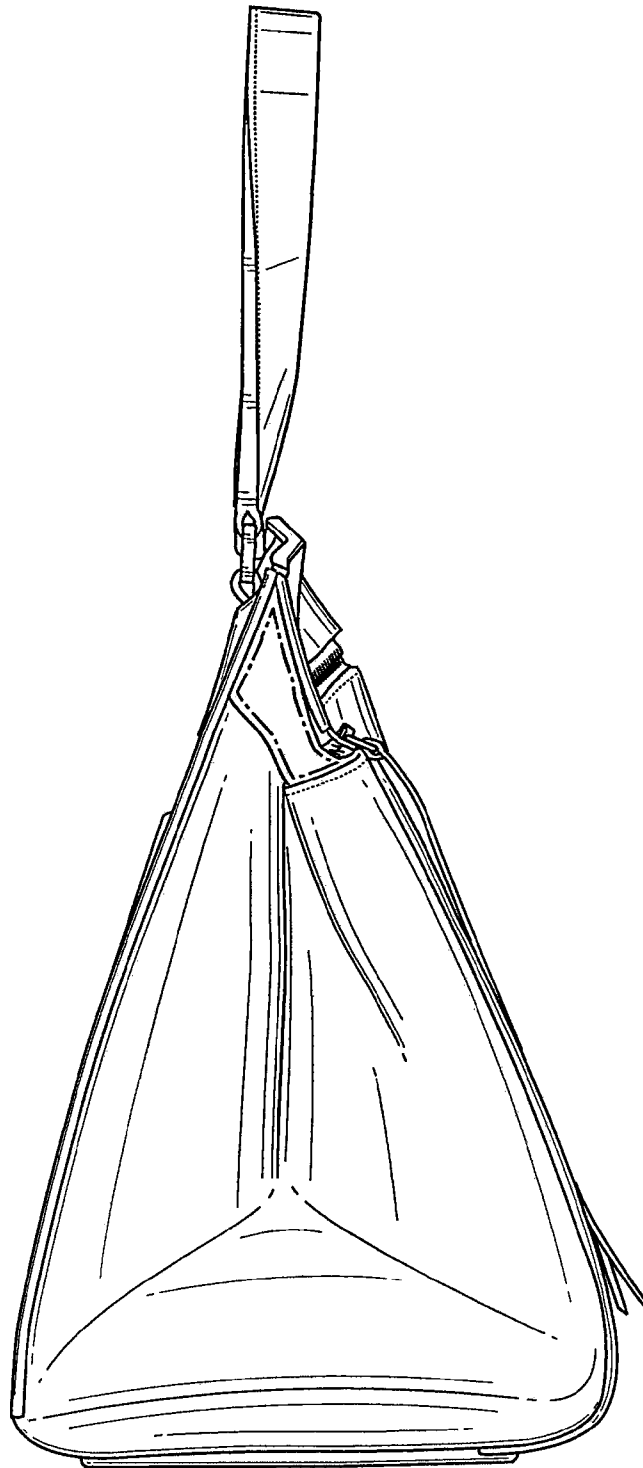

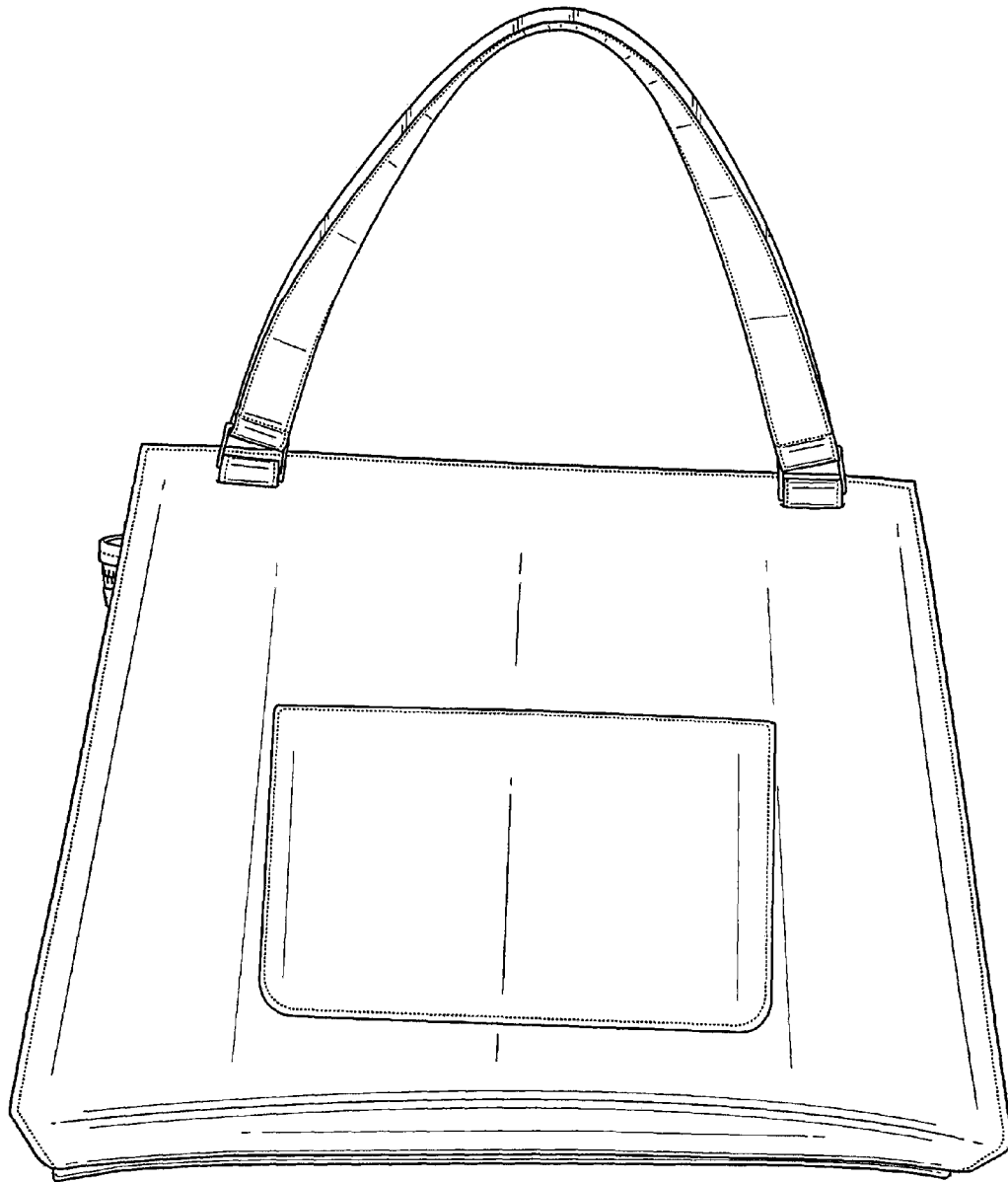

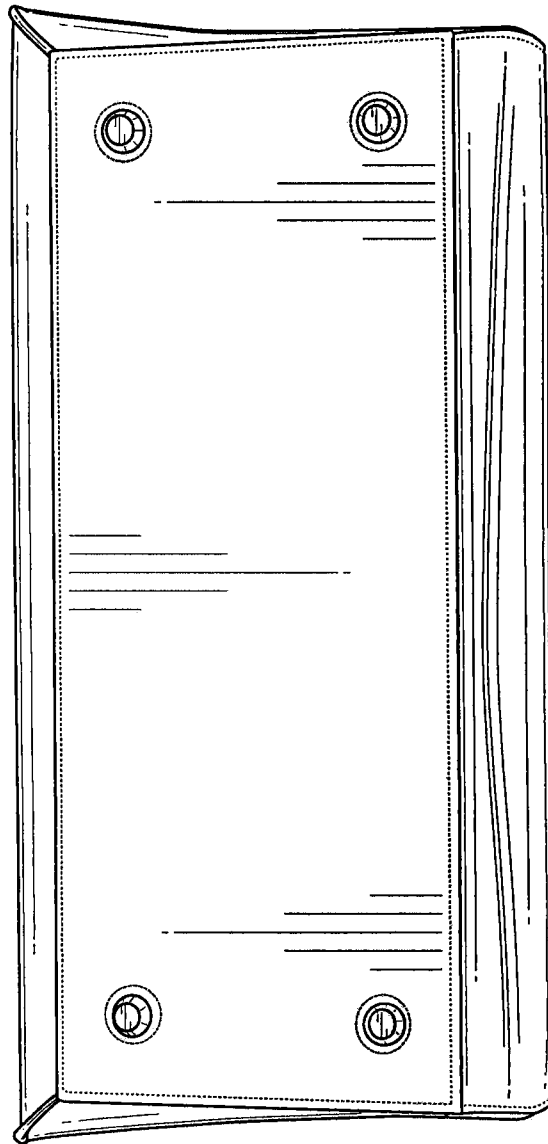

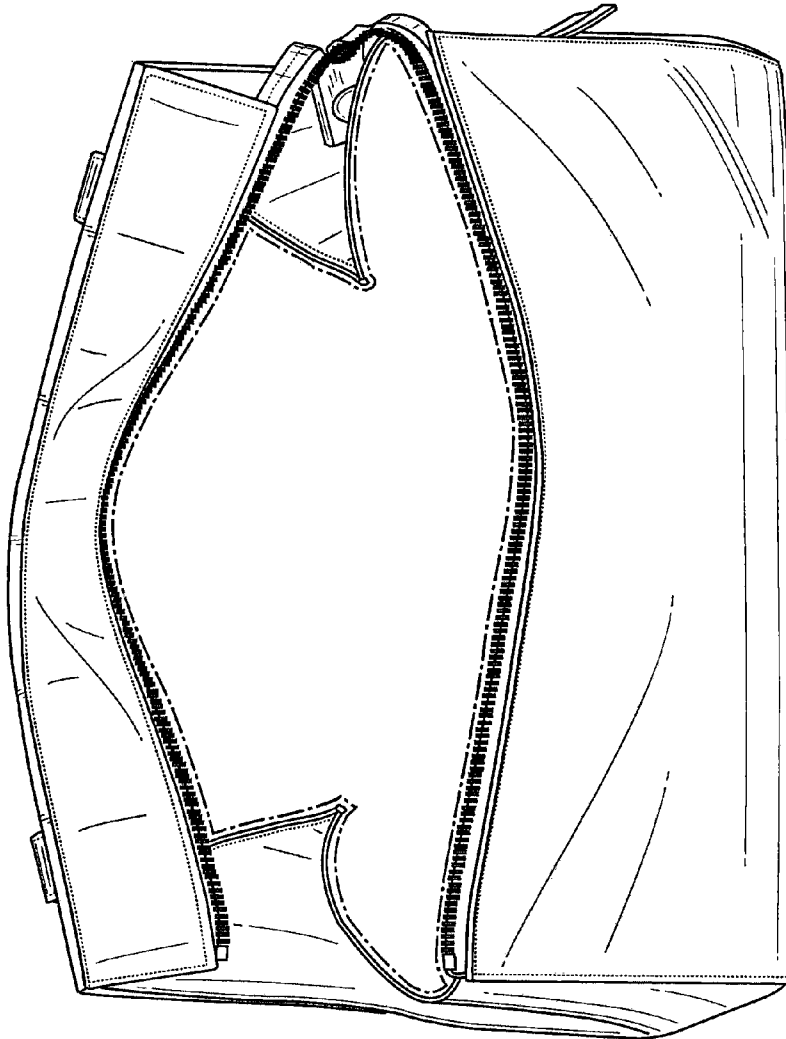
