FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof; and,

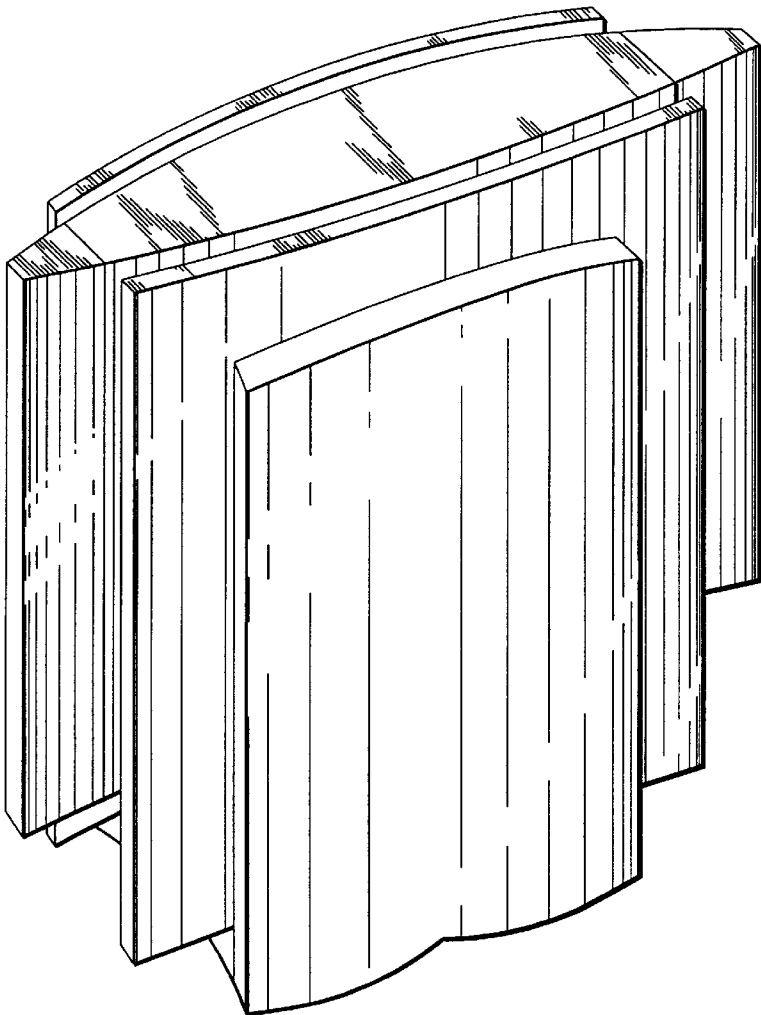
FIG. 5 is a front, left side, and top perspective view thereof.

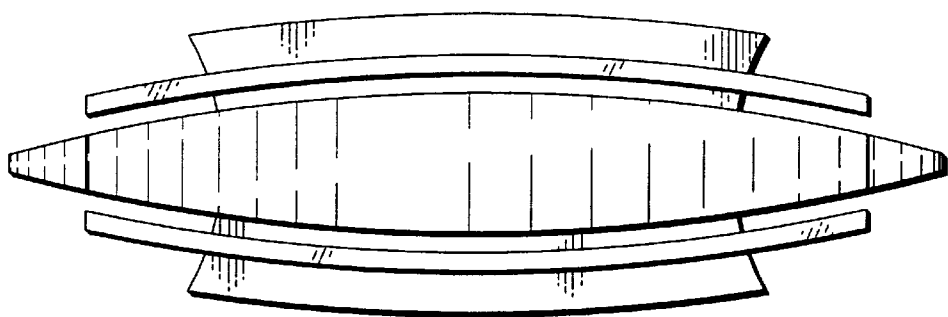

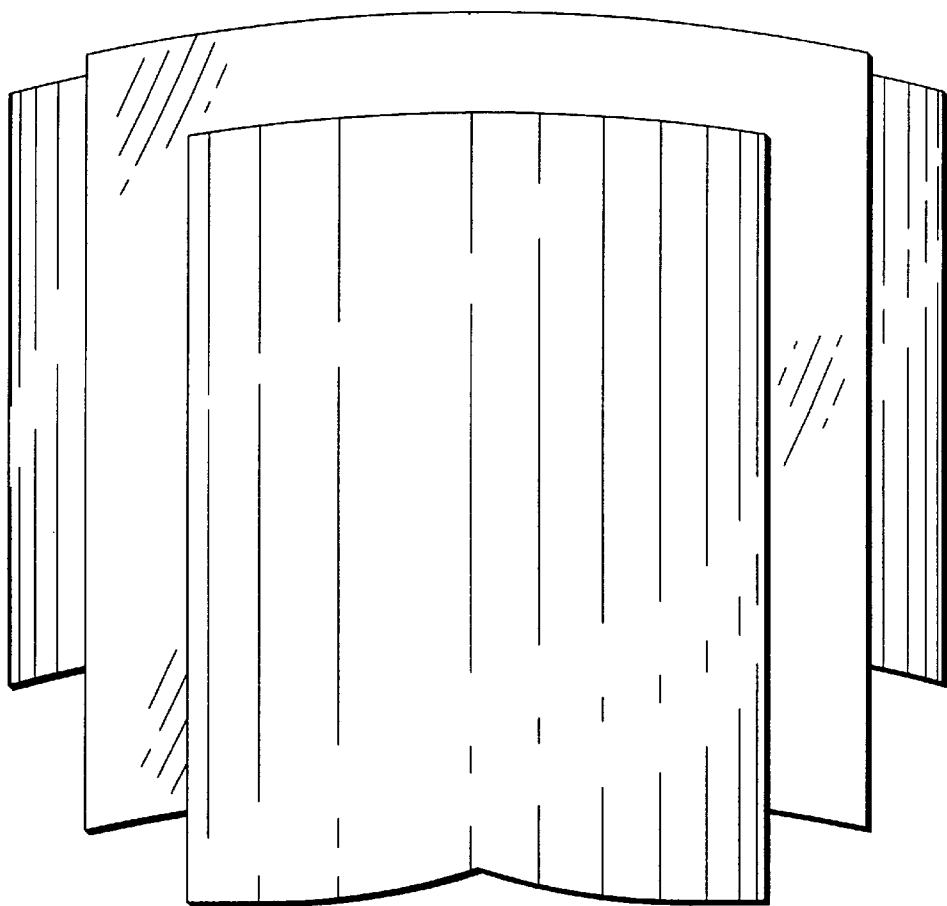

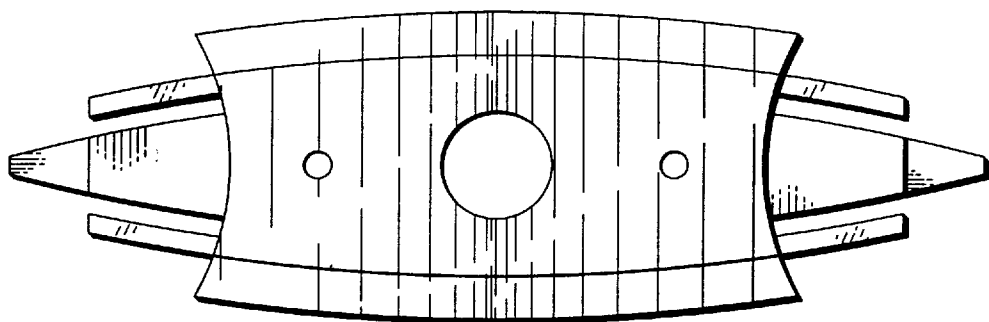

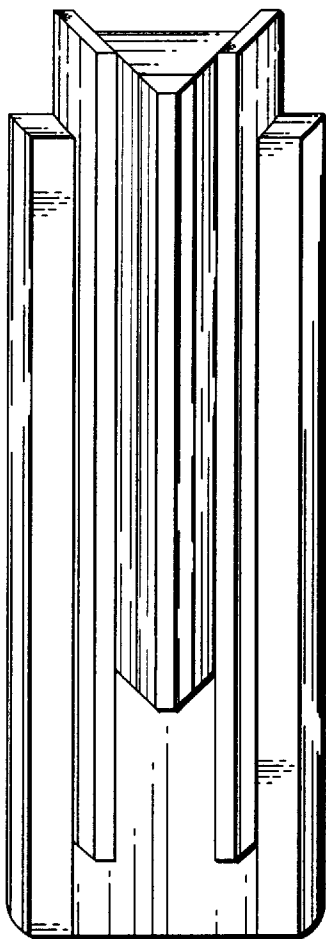

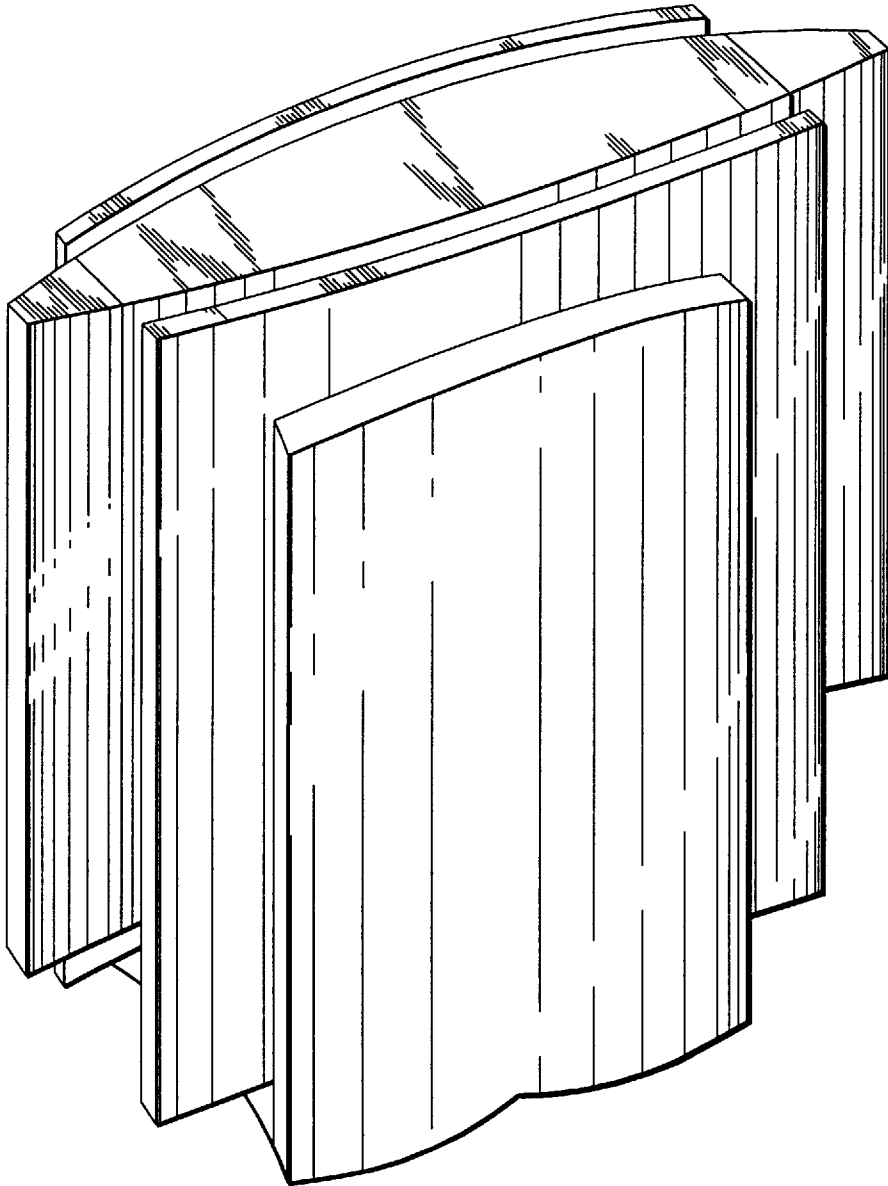
