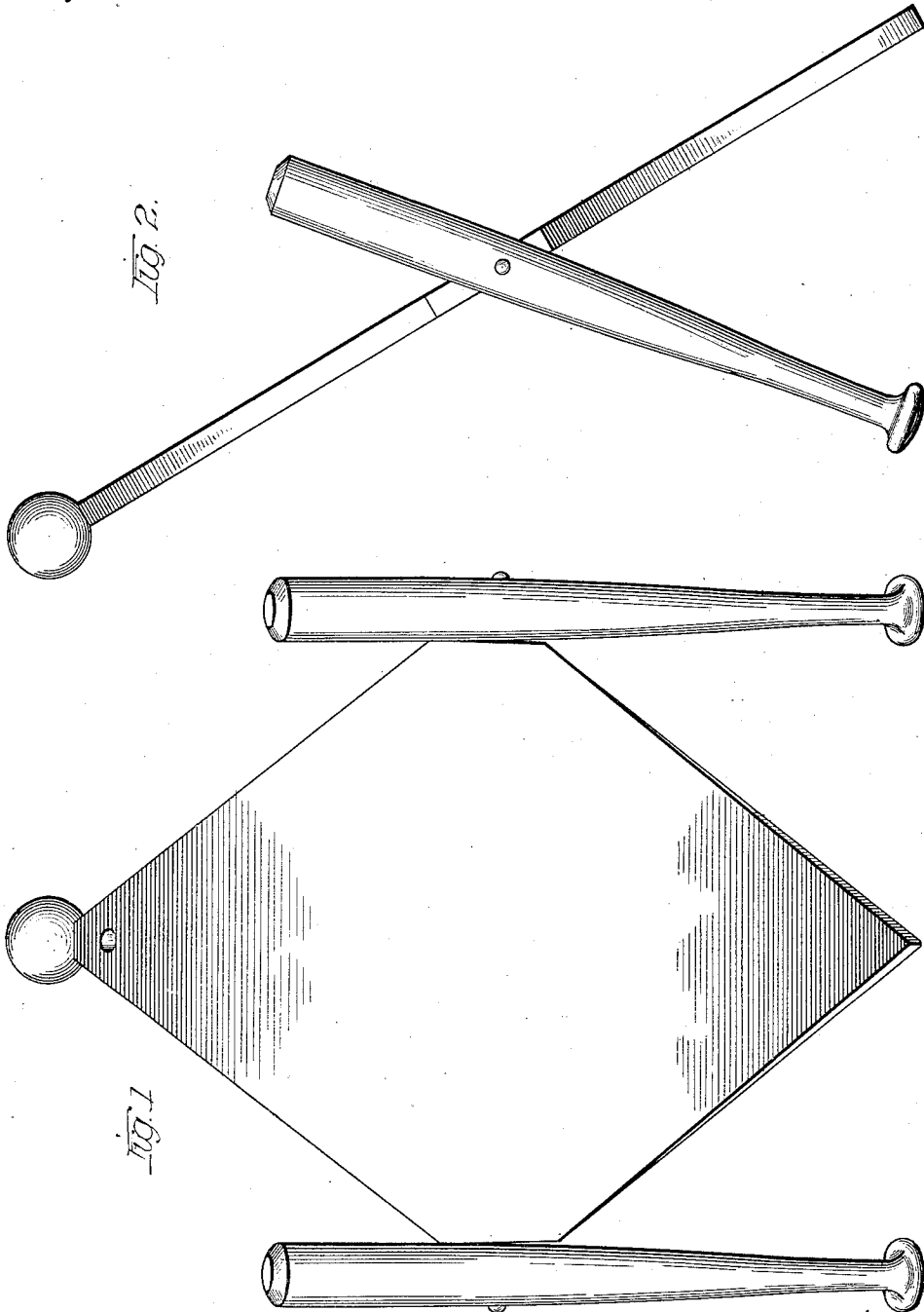

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, WILLIAM MAHLOCH, a citizen of the United States, residing at Chicago, in the county of Cook and State of Illinois, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Wall or Table Ornaments, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawings, forming a part thereof.

Figure 1 is a front elevation and Fig. 2 a side elevation of a wall or table ornament showing my new design.
