



DESIGN FOR A SLIPPER OR SIMILAR ARTICLE

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Dominick J. Calderazzo, a citizen of the United States of America, residing in the city of New York, county of New York, and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Slipper or Similar Article, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

Fig. 1 is a plan view of a slipper or similar article showing my new design.
