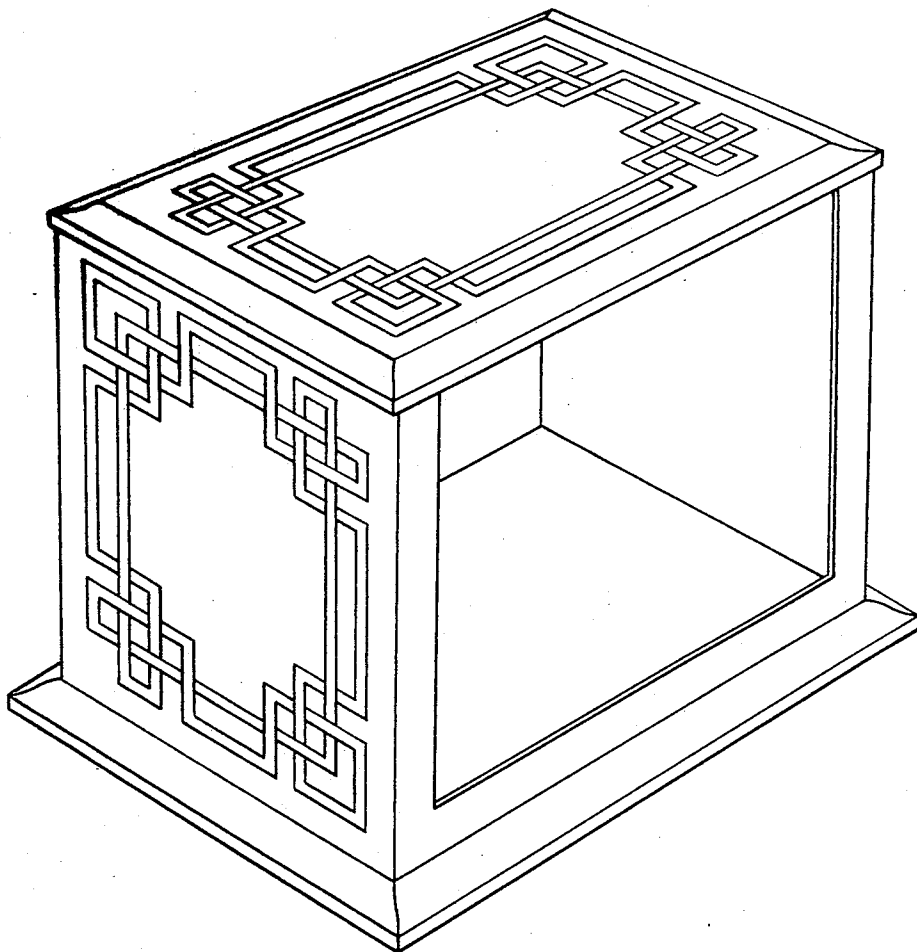

DESIGN FOR A RADIO-INSTRUMENT CABINET.

Application filed February 23, 1924. Serial No. 8,713. Term of patent $3\frac{1}{2}$ years.
