



To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, William S. Warren, a citizen of the United States, residing at Meriden, county of New Haven and State of Connecticut, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Spoon or Other Article of Flatware, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.

Fig. 1 is a front view of a spoon showing my new design;

Fig. 2 is a sectional view thereof taken on line 2—2 of Fig. 1;

Fig. 3 is a sectional view thereof taken on line 3—3 of Fig. 1.
