

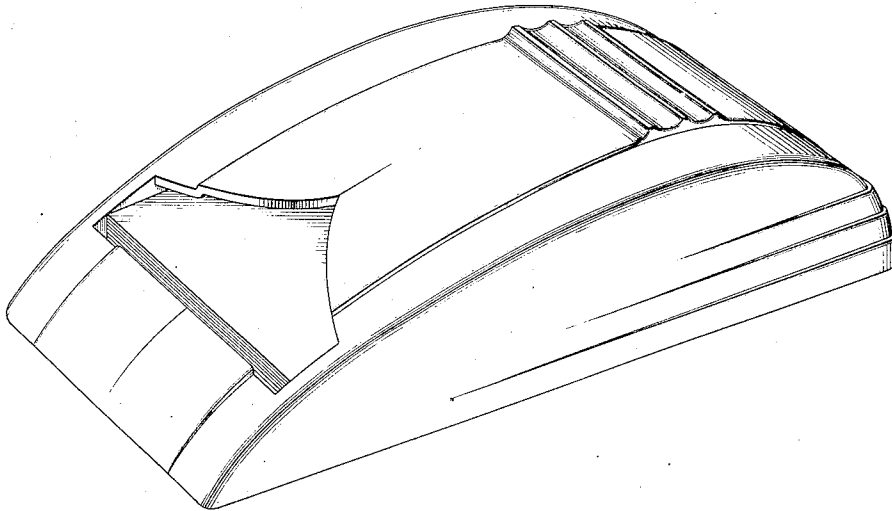

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, William B. Petzold, a citizen of the United States, residing at Pittsfield, in the county of Berkshire, State of Massachusetts, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Desk Pad Unit, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.

In the accompanying drawing, the figure is a

perspective view of a desk pad unit showing my new design. The opposite side of the desk pad unit presents the same appearance as the side shown.
