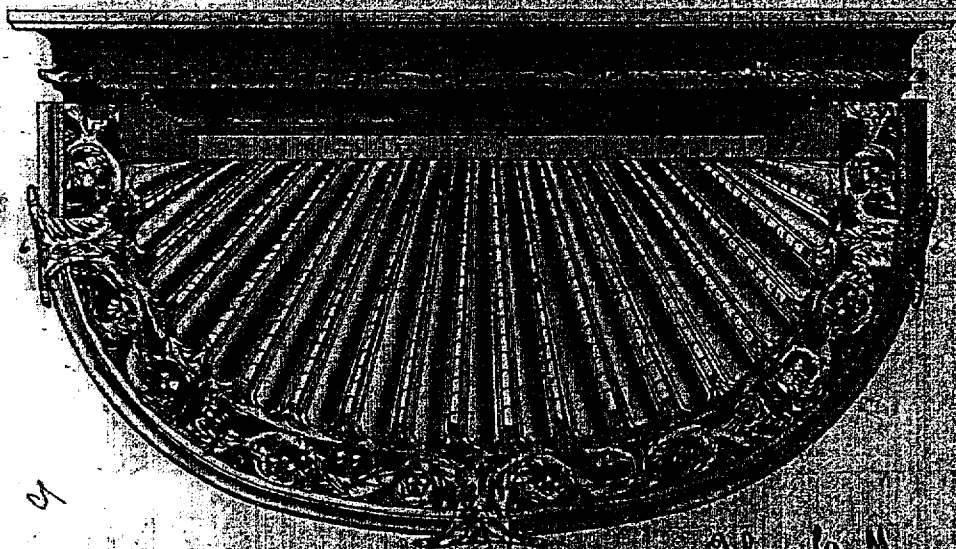

Letters Patent N^o. 814. Dated July 8th 1856.

The schedule referred to in these Letters Patent, and making part of the same.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, John C. Macy, of the city of Cincinnati, in the County of Hamilton, and State of Ohio, have invented or produced a new and original design for Ornamental Grates for Fire-places, and I do hereby declare that the following is a full, and exact description thereof, reference being had to the accompanying drawings, forming part of this specification, and to the figures of reference marked thereon.

Fig. A, represents an elevation of the front of the Grate, drawn separate from the Fender.

Fig. B, represents a top view of the Fender, and is drawn in connection with the front of the Grate. The top edge of the front is seen in this view, together with the moulding on and against which the ornamental part of the front is attached.

a, a, represents the plate constituting the front of the Grate, and is provided with mouldings 2, around its inner edge, and

5. is a Cavetto moulding, commencing from the surface of the plate as, as represented in Fig. B., and against which the ornamental piece 1, 1, is placed, which has an arched form and extends around the edge of the plate as seen in Fig. A.

The Fender is ornamented on its edge with a combination of mouldings, and made to rest on three feet 6, 6, 6, ornamented with leaves which blend themselves into that portion of the ornaments on the Fender marked 4, which consists of leaves and flowers as represented in the accompanying drawing.

The centre portion of the Fender is ornamented with radial ridges 3, 3, or nearly semi-cylindrical forms in relief, every other one and the smaller ones being ornamented with transverse inclined notches, and the ends of the same being formed with a series of ornamental forms, as fully represented in the accompanying drawings.

What I claim as my invention or production, and desire to secure by Letters Patent, is the ornamental design, configuration and arrangement of the front plate and Fender of Grates as herein described in this specification and represented in the accompanying drawings.
