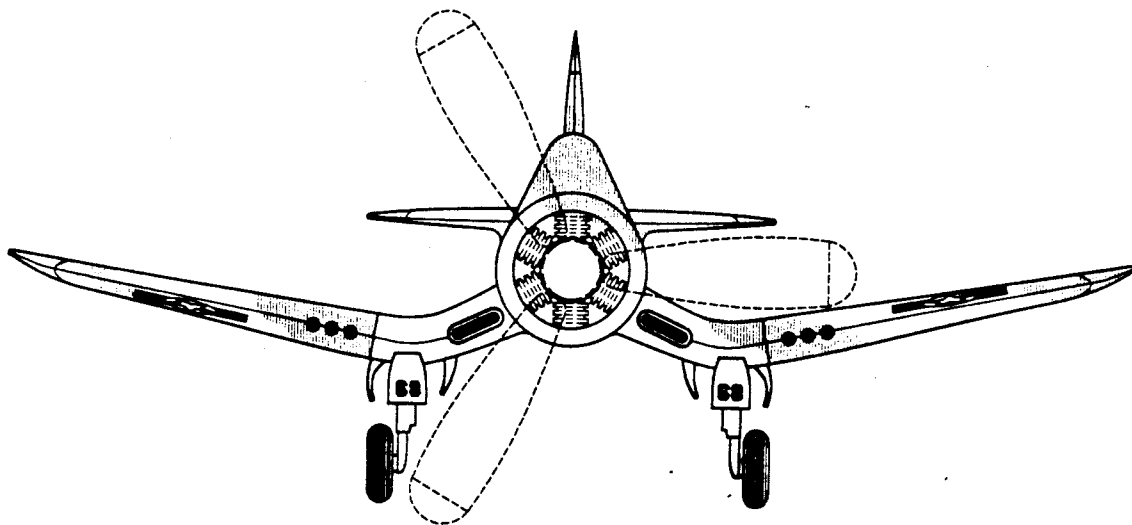
[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for an applique for use with a ceiling fan, as shown and described.

The broken line showing of a ceiling fan shown in FIG. 1 is for illustrative purposes only, and forms no part of the claimed design.



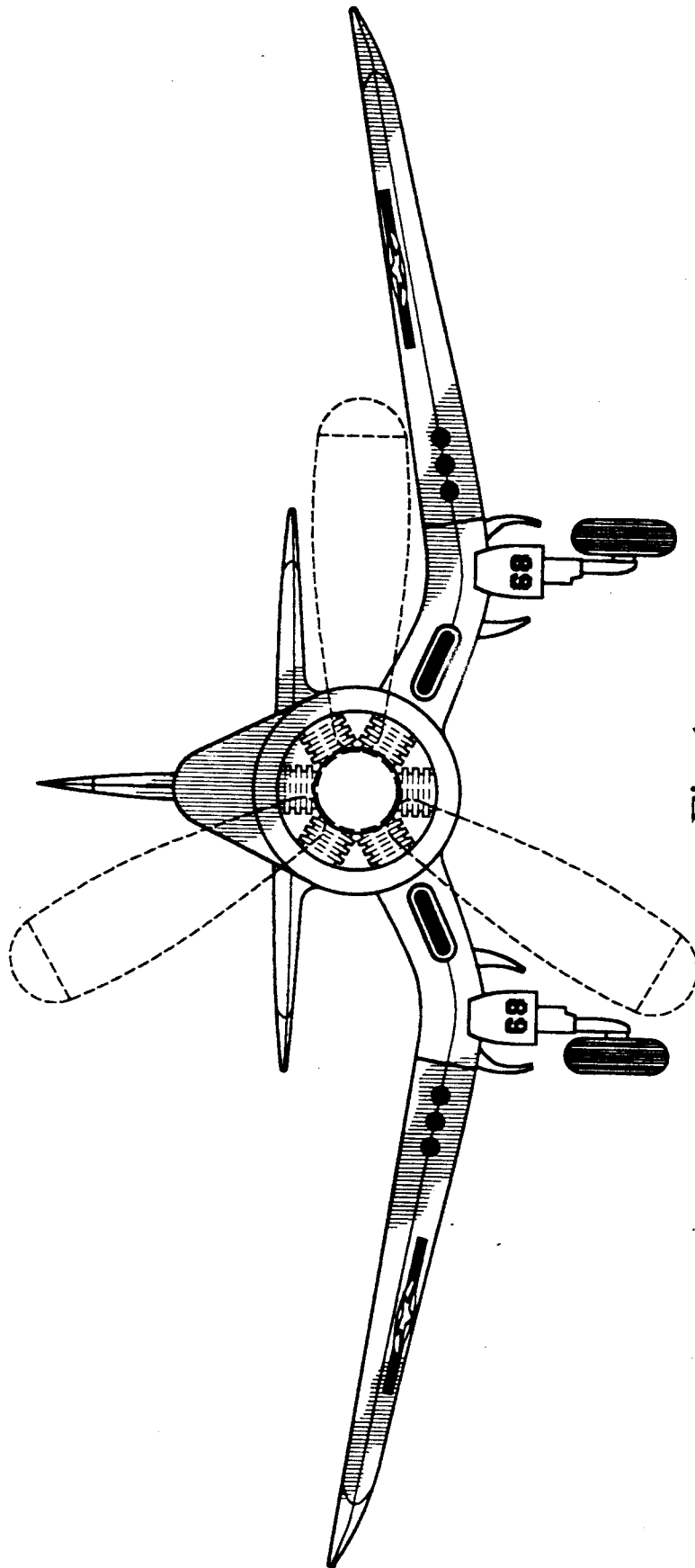

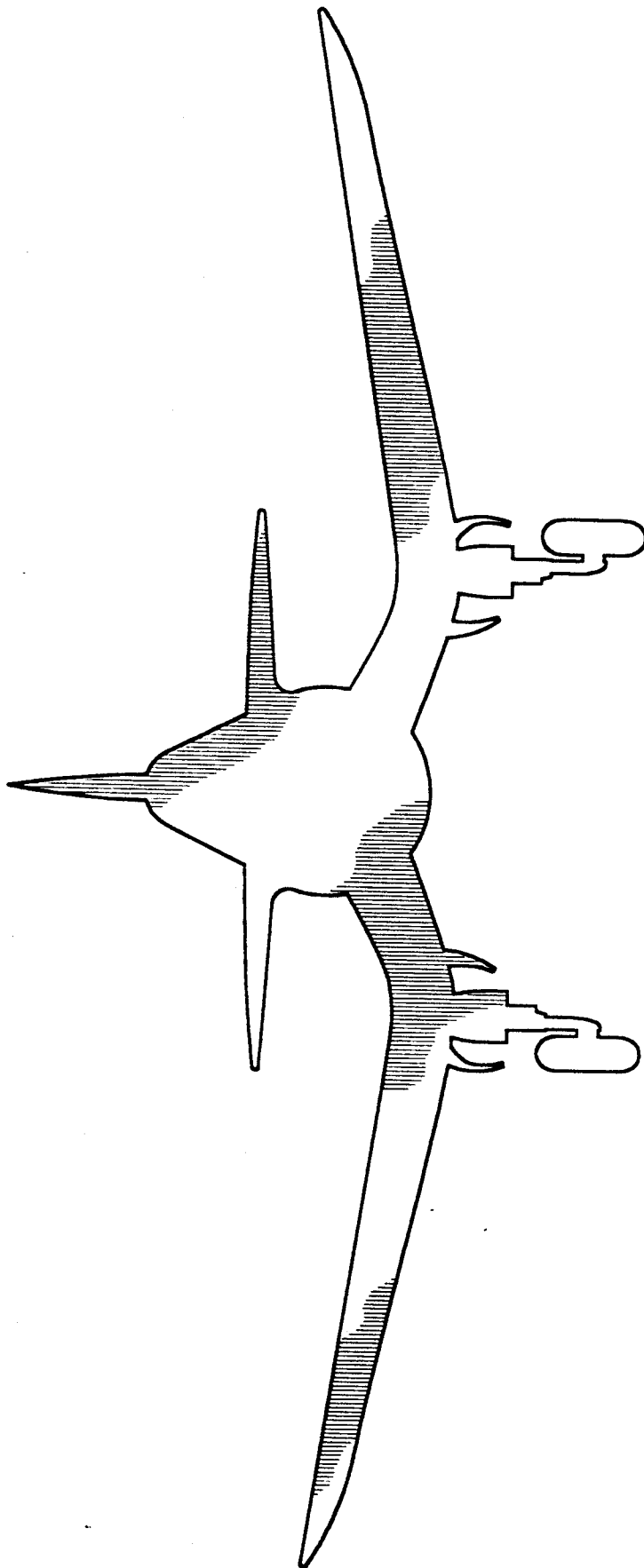
