

DESIGN FOR A SHOE SOLE OR SIMILAR ARTICLE

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that we, Henry Ghez and Oscar Ghez, both citizens of Tunisia, Africa, of 30 Rockefeller Plaza, New York, N. Y., U. S. A., have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Shoe Sole or Similar Article, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

Figure 1 is a bottom plan view of a shoe sole or similar article showing our new design.

Figure 2 is a longitudinal section of the same on line 2—2 in Figure 1.

Figure 3 is a transverse section of the same on line 3—3 in said Figure 1.
