

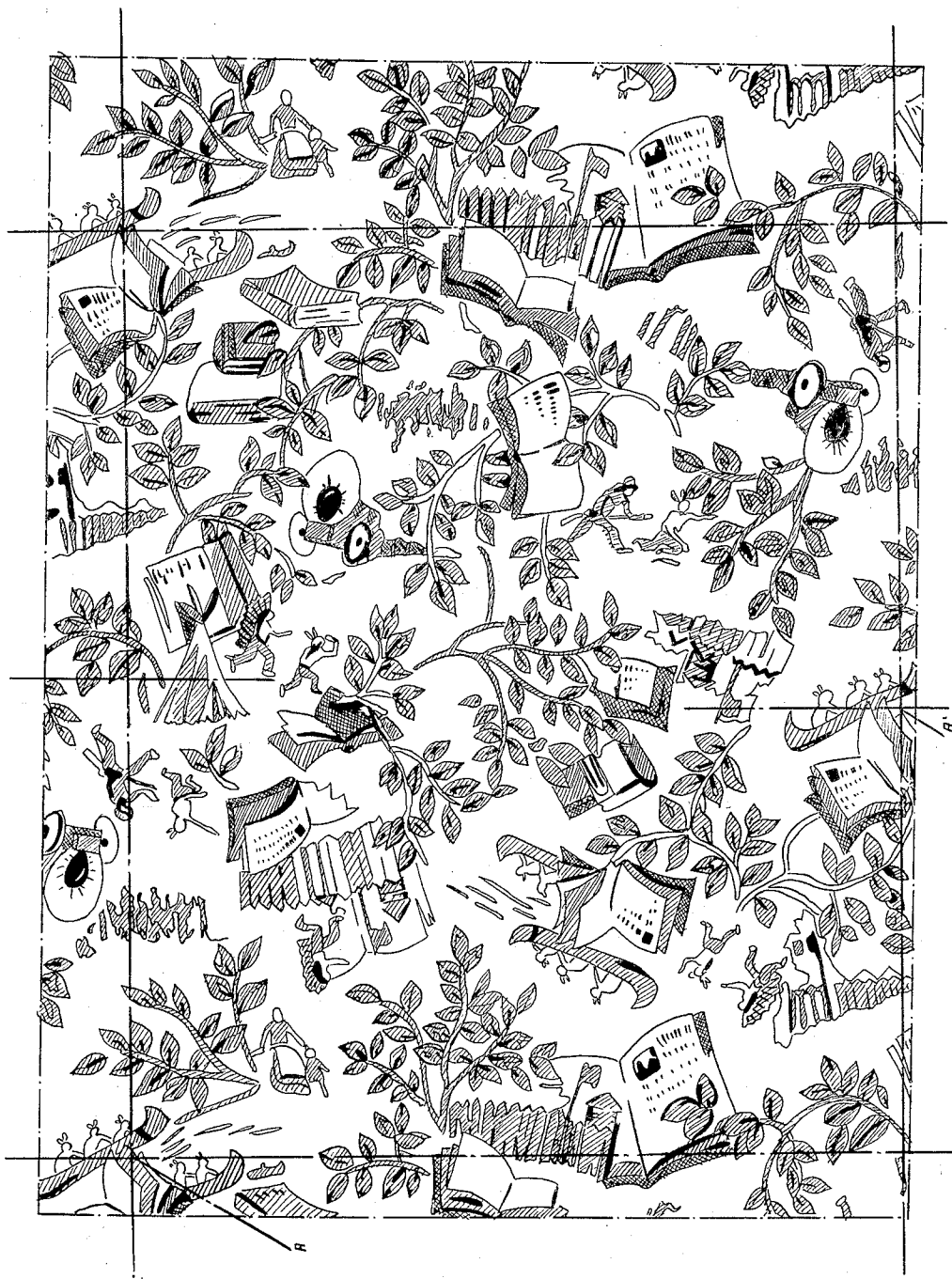

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, Paul Reiman, a citizen of the Republic of Germany, residing in the city of New York, county of New York, and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Textile Fabric, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof,

The figure is a plan view of a textile fabric showing my new design.

The dot and dash lines on the drawing show the design unit, which unit is repeated in staggered succession, as indicated by the angles A and A'.
