

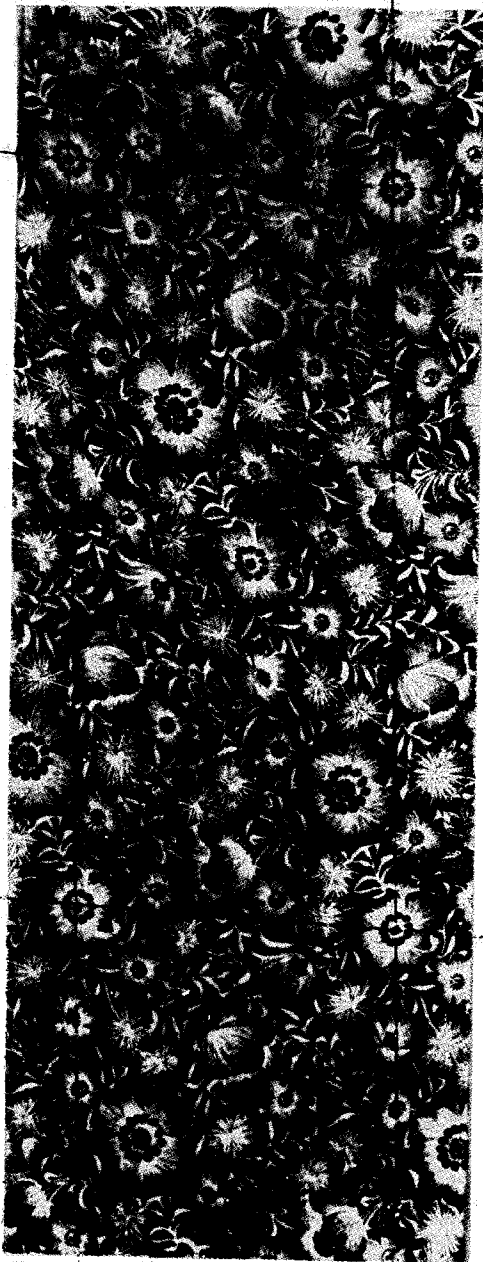

DESIGN FOR A TEXTILE FABRIC OR SIMILAR ARTICLE

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Max L. Cohen, a citizen of the United States, residing in New York city, in the county of New York and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Textile Fabric or Similar Article, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

The figure is a plan view of a textile fabric showing my design.

The design unit is contained between the dot and dash lines, which unit is repeated in regular succession as indicated by the extension beyond the unit boundaries.

I claim:

The ornamental design for a textile fabric or similar article, substantially as shown and described.
