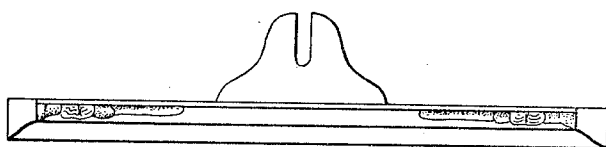

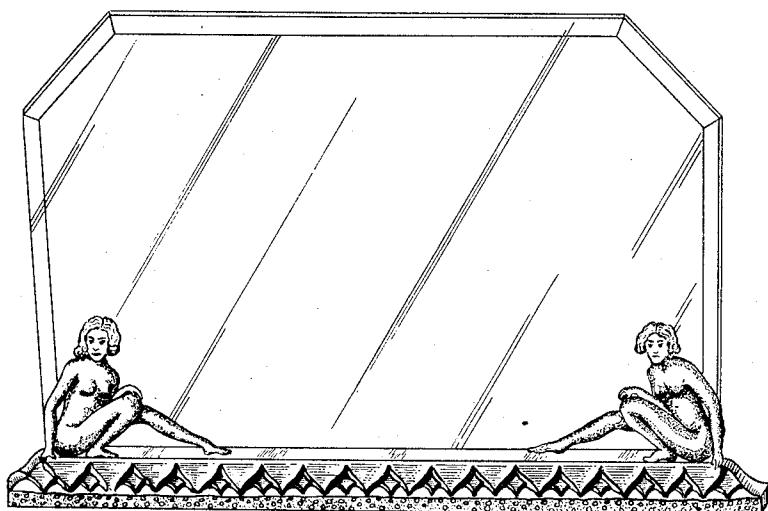

DESIGN FOR A LAMP SCREEN

To all whom it may concern:
