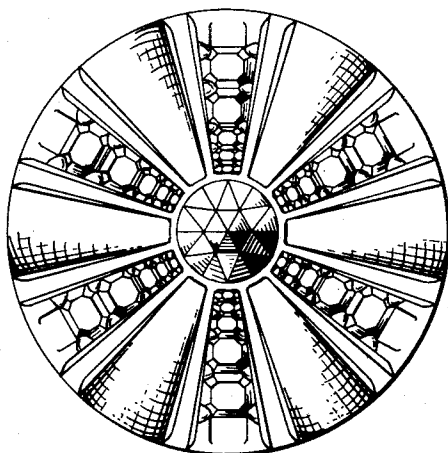
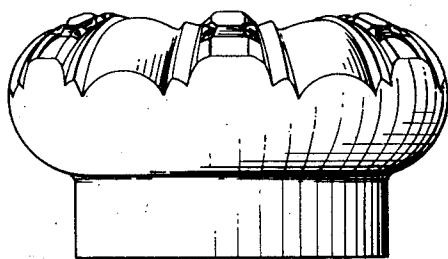

Be it known that I, Albert Mosheim, a citizen of the United States and a resident of the city of New York, county of New York, and State of New York, have invented a certain new, original, and ornamental Design for a Combined Stopper and Handle of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing forming part thereof:
