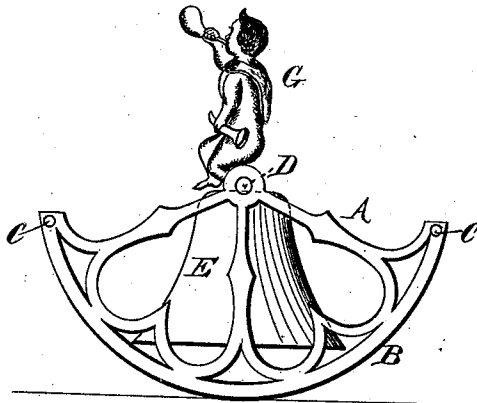
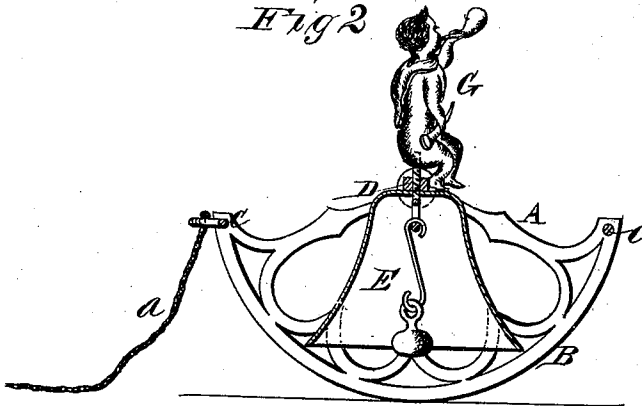

IMPROVEMENT IN TOY BELLS.

Specification forming part of Letters Patent No. **179,989**, dated July 18, 1876; application filed February 10, 1876.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, CHAS. A. BAILEY, of Cobalt, in the county of Middlesex, and in the State of Connecticut, have invented certain new and useful Improvements in Toy Bells; and do hereby declare that the following is a full, clear, and exact description thereof, reference being had to the accompanying drawings, and to the letters of reference marked thereon, making a part of this specification.

My invention relates to toy bells; and it consists in the construction of the same, as will be hereinafter more fully set forth.

In order to enable others skilled in the art to which my invention appertains to make and use the same, I will now proceed to describe its construction and operation, referring to the annexed drawing, in which—

Figure 1 is a side elevation of my invention. Fig. 2 is a longitudinal section of the same.

A A represent two segmental frames, the rims of which form the rockers B B, and which are connected at their ends by rounds or bars C C. D is a rod or bar connecting the frames

A in the center at the top, and to said rod is attached a bell, E, depending from the same, and on top is an ornamental figure, G. More than one bell may be attached to the rod D, if desired.

The toy bell thus constructed may be rocked back and forth, or drawn across the floor by a string, a, attached to one of the rods C.

Having thus fully described my invention, what I claim as new, and desire to secure by Letters Patent, is—

The combination of the two segmental frames A A, with rockers B B, and central connecting-rod D, having the bell E depending therefrom, as and for the purposes herein set forth.
