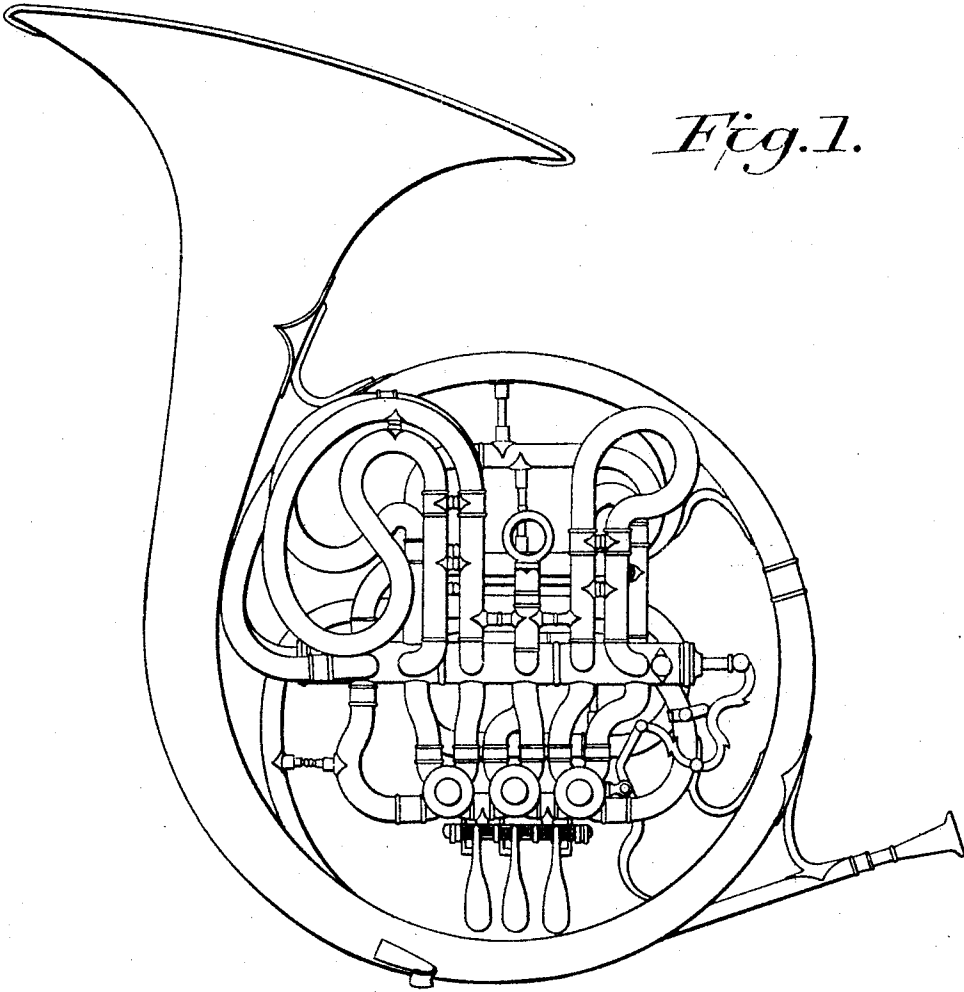

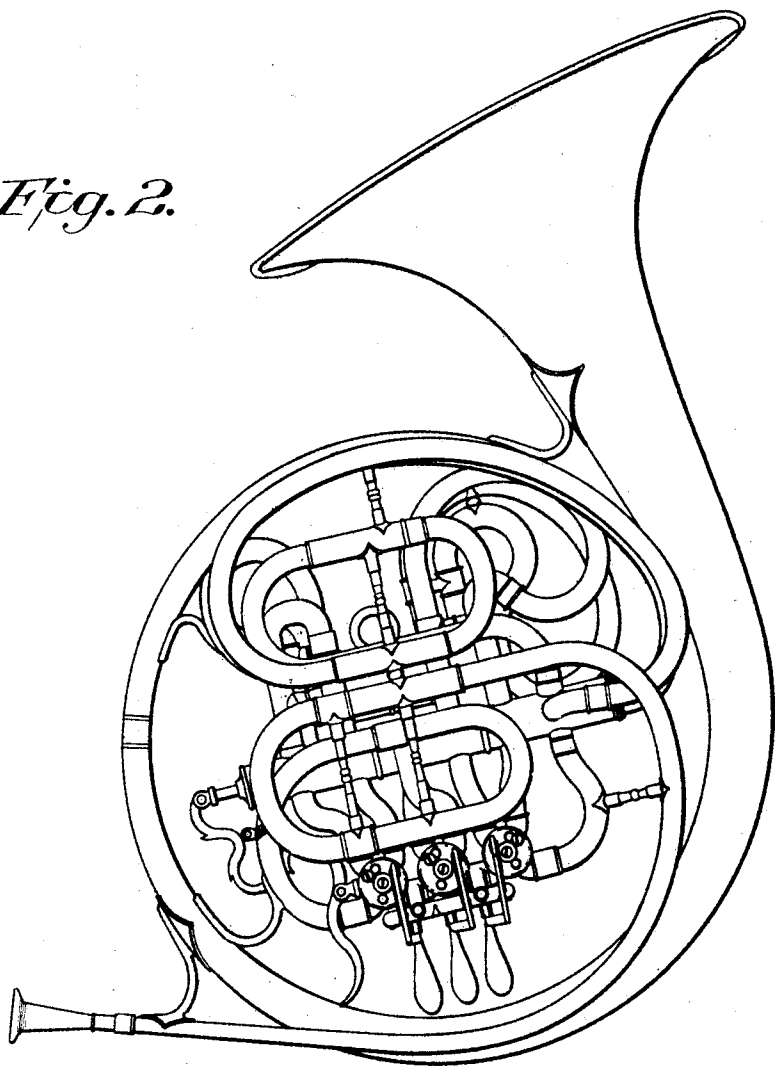

Be it known that I, ORA DOTSON, a citizen of the United States, residing in the city of Elkhart, county of Elkhart, Indiana, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Double Horn, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawings, forming a part hereof.
