

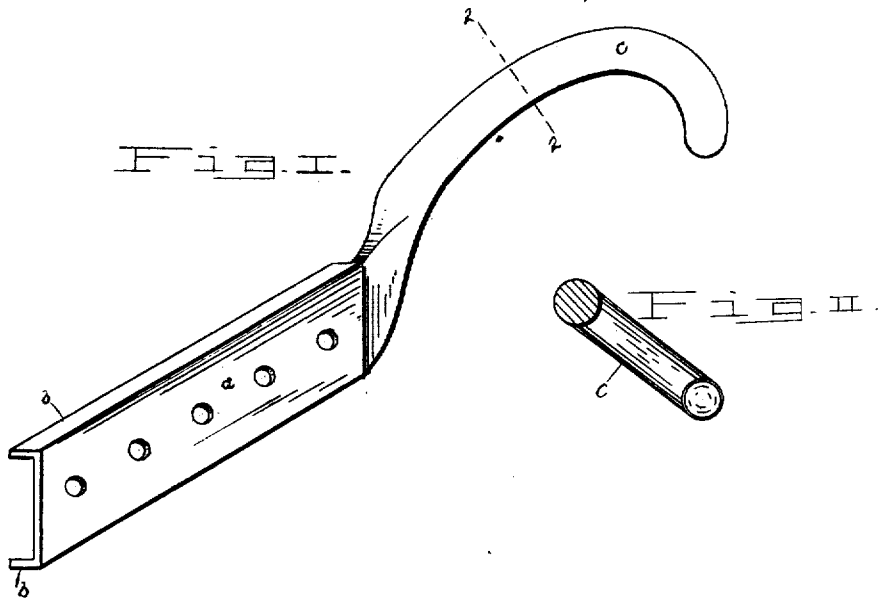

DESIGN FOR A PLOW-HANDLE.

SPECIFICATION forming part of Design No. 31,596, dated October 3, 1899.

Application filed August 29, 1899. Serial No. 728,914. Term of patent 7 years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, JAMES W. BROWN, a citizen of the United States, residing at Shady Grove, in the county of Upsher and State of Texas, have invented and produced a new and original Design for Plow-Handles, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawings, forming part thereof.

10 In the drawings, Figure 1 shows a perspective view of a plow-handle embodying my design, and Fig. 2 shows a section on line 2 2 of Fig. 1.

15 As shown in the drawings, the leading or material feature of the design consists of a main or body portion *a*, the upper and lower edges of which are substantially parallel and from which there extend at right angles to the face of the body flanges *b*, which flanges

extend from one end of the body to the other. 20
The upper and lower edges of the body portion are continued upwardly in compound curves, gradually drawing together and then continuing parallel to form the rounded and arc-shaped handle portion *c*. Intermediate 25
the upper and lower edges of the body portion *a* is formed a line of perforations extending through the body and at right angles thereto.

Having thus described my invention, what I claim as new, and desire to secure by Letters Patent, is—

The design for a plow-handle, as herein shown and described.
