

DESIGN FOR A LAWN-HOSE SUPPORT.

SPECIFICATION forming part of Design No. 32,226, dated February 13, 1900.

Application filed December 22, 1899. Serial No. 741,346. Term of patent 7 years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, ISAAC R. DOTSON, a citizen of the United States of America, residing and having my post-office address in the city of Dayton, county of Montgomery, and State of Ohio, have invented a certain new and original Design for a Lawn-Hose Support; and I hereby declare that the following is a clear, full, and exact description thereof, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, in which like figures refer to like parts.

The figure in the drawing illustrates a perspective view of a lawn-hose support embodying my invention and design.

The essential feature of my invention and design consists of a lawn-hose support having at its upper end two substantially U-shaped openings at an angle to each other.

In said drawing, 10 represents said lawn-hose support. 11 and 12 represent said substantially U-shaped openings at its upper end at an angle to each other. Said openings 11 and 12 are wider at their open ends, and the lower end of said hose support 10 is provided with a point 14.

What I claim is—

The design for a lawn-hose support, substantially as shown and described.
