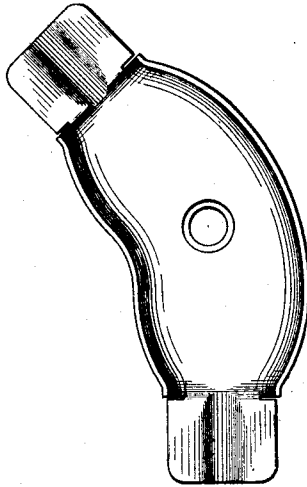

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, CHAUNCEY W. ABBOTT, a citizen of the United States, residing at Pittsburgh, in the county of Allegheny and State of Pennsylvania, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Forty-Five-Degree Flat Elbow-Base for Fittings for Electrical Conduits, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

In the drawings, Figure 1 is a plan view, Fig. 2 is a side view from the left in Fig. 1,

and Fig. 3 is a side view from the bottom in Fig. 1 of a forty-five degree flat elbow base for fittings for electrical conduits, showing my new design.
