



DESIGN FOR AN OVER-BED TABLE

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, William A. Hillenbrand, a citizen of the United States, residing at Batesville, in the county of Ripley and State of Indiana, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for an Over-Bed Table, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.

Figure 1 is a perspective view of an over-bed table, showing my new design.

Figure 2 is an end elevational view thereof, the lower end as shown being broken away.

Figure 3 is a fragmentary perspective view from the rear of the over-bed table on a somewhat reduced scale.

The dominant feature of the design resides in the portion shown in full lines.

I claim:

The ornamental design for an over-bed table, substantially as shown and described.
