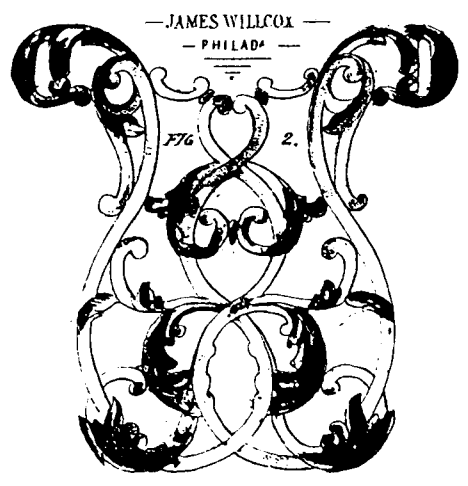
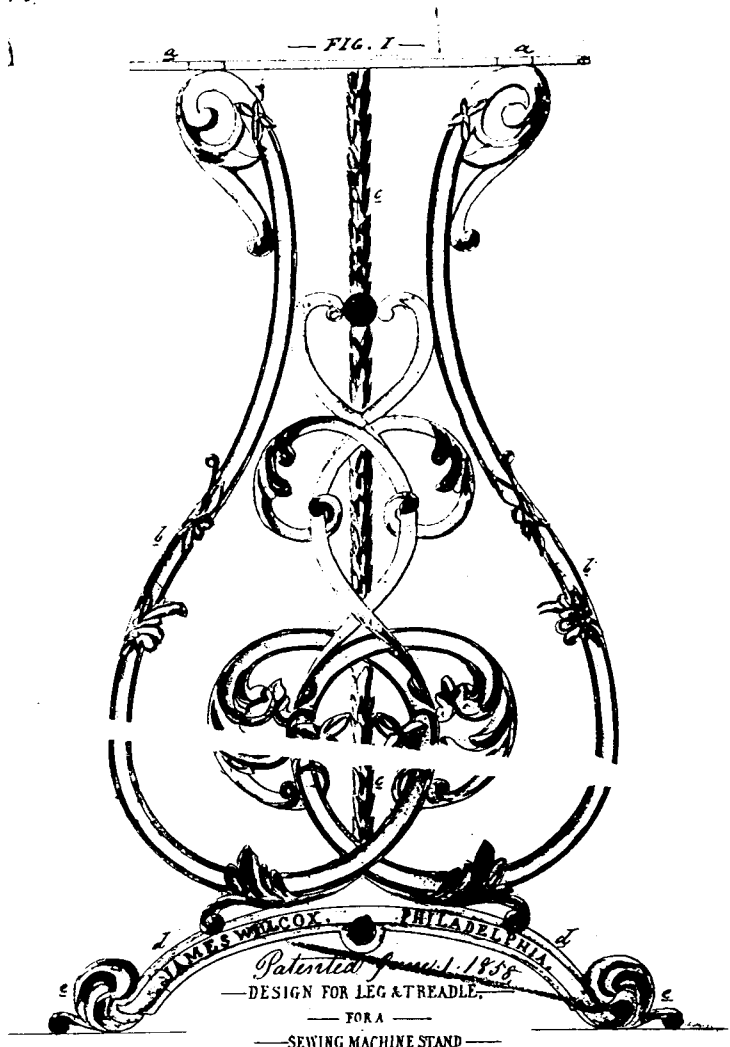

Letters Patent No. 1012. dated June 1<sup>st</sup> 1858.

The schedule referred to in these Letters Patent & making part of the same.

To all whom it may concern:—

Be it Known that I, James Willcox, of the City of Philadelphia, and State of Pennsylvania, have invented or produced a new and original design for a leg and traddle forming part of a stand for a Sewing Machine, and I do hereby declare the following to be a full and exact description of the same, reference being had to the accompanying drawing and to the letters of reference marked thereon.

Fig. 1 represents a side view of a cast iron ornamental leg of a stand for a sewing machine, *a*, being the plate for receiving the table, and this plate surmounting the indented and foliated scrolls *b* & *b'*, as well as the serrated column *c*, which together with the intertwined & foliated continuations of the scrolls, forms the central portion of the leg, the whole resting on the arched base *d*, which terminates in the foliated feet *e* & *e'*.

Fig. 2, represents a plan view of the traddle to be hung to the legs, and consists of two intertwined foliated scrolls of a similar character to, although differing in arrangement from those of the leg.

I claim and desire to secure by Letters Patent, the combina-

tion and arrangement of ornamental figures and forms represented in and by the accompanying drawing, as forming together an ornamental design for a part of a Sewing Machine Stand.
