FIG. 1 is a left front perspective view of a sports shoe showing my new design;

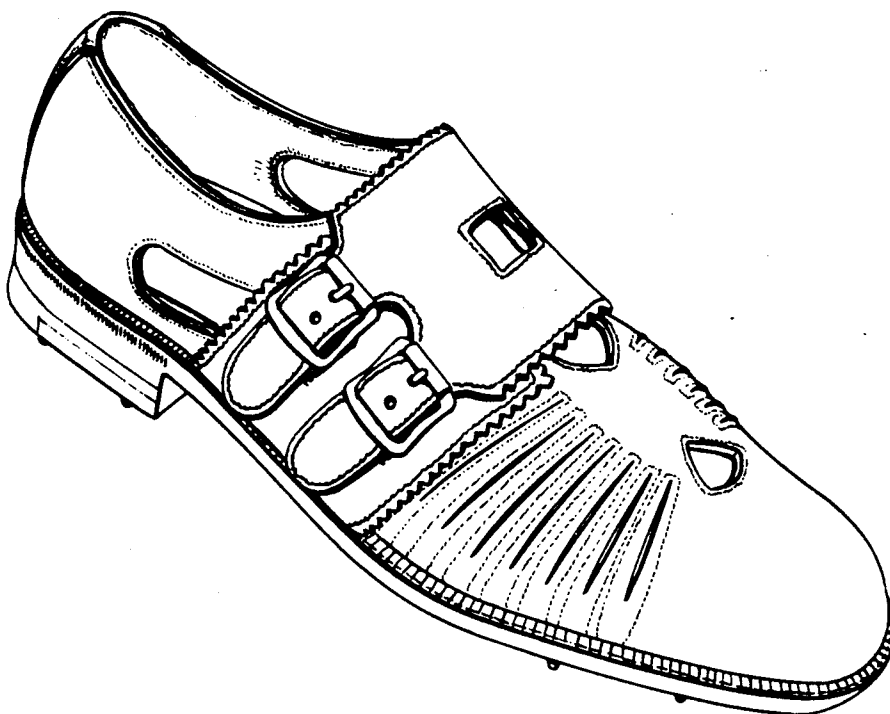
FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof with the shoe unfastened.



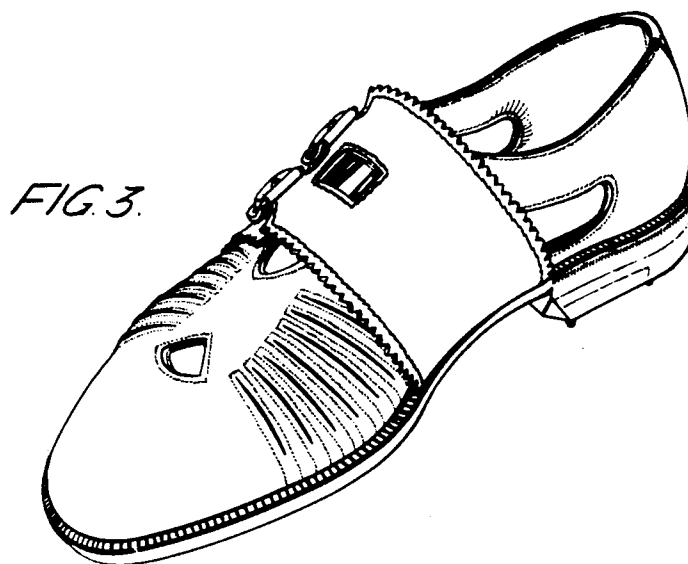
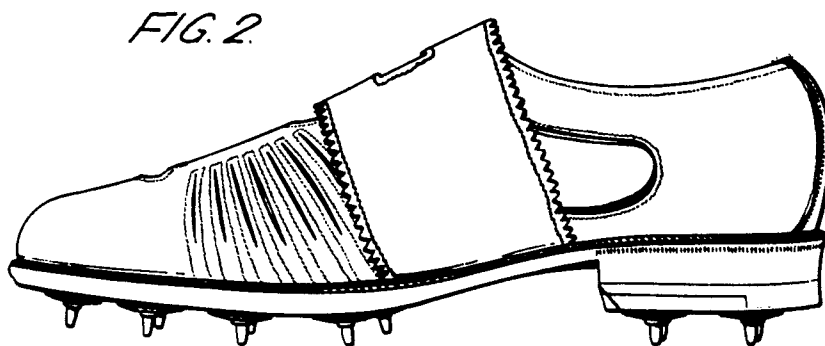
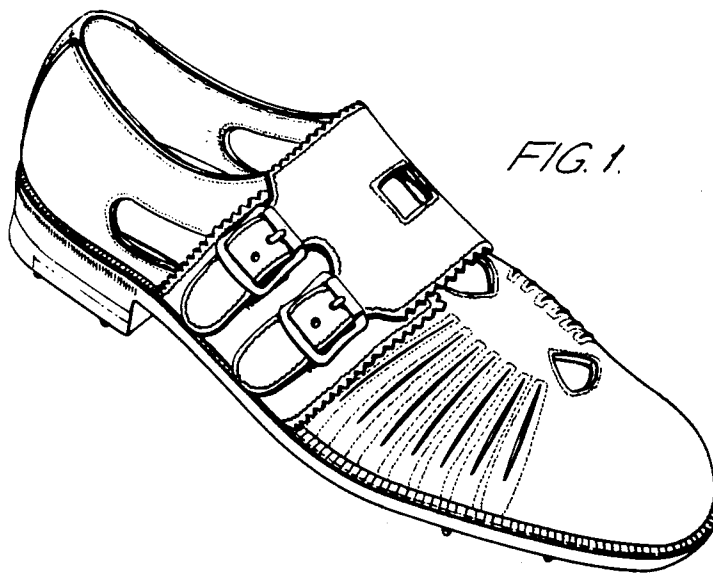

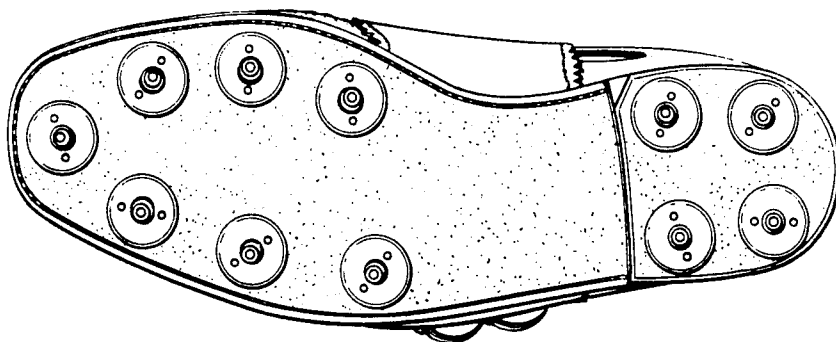

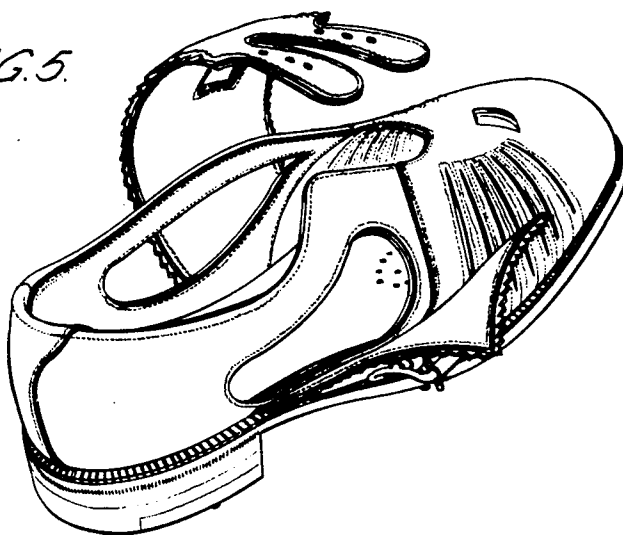
