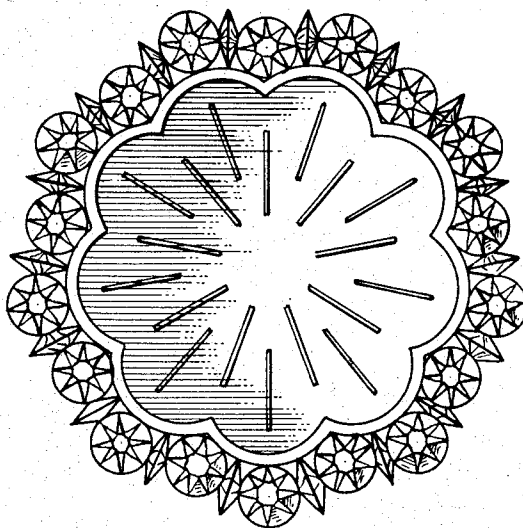
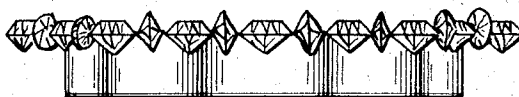

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Abraham Levine, a citizen of the United States of America, and resident of the city of New York, county of Bronx, and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Coaster or Similar Article, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof in which Fig. 1 is a top plan view of a coaster or similar article, showing my new design, and Fig. 2 is a side elevational view of the same.
