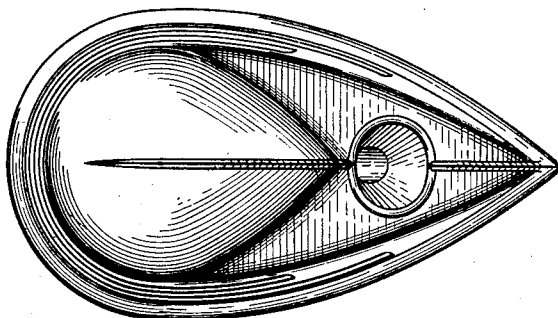

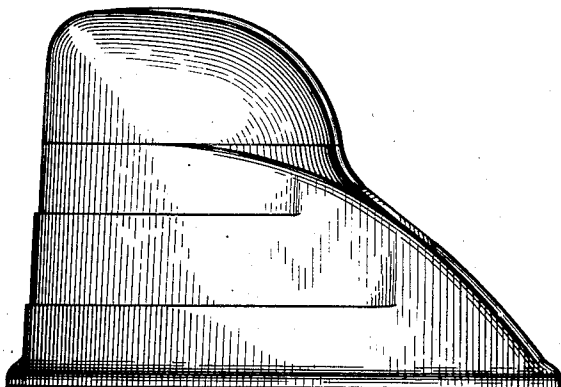
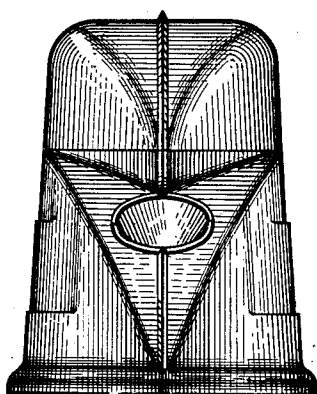

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Robert Rose, a citizen of the United States, residing at Chicago, in the county of Cook and State of Illinois, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Reservoir Desk Stand or Similar Article, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.

In the drawing:

Figure 1 is a top plan view of a reservoir desk stand or similar article embodying my new design;

Fig. 2 is a side elevational view of Fig. 1; and
Fig. 3 is a front elevational view of Fig. 1.
