DESIGN FOR A FONT OF PRINTING-TYPE.

SPECIFICATION forming part of Design No. 12,630, dated December 27, 1881.

Application filed November 19, 1881. Term of patent 7 years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, JAMES M. CONNER, of the city, county, and State of New York, have invented and produced a new and original Design for a Font of Printing-Type, of which the following is a specification.

The nature of my design is clearly shown in the accompanying typographic impression, to which reference is made; and it consists of a sloping script letter. In the C, E, G, and S the letters are ornamented upon the right by a curved line extending from the upper portion of the letter below its lower portion and curved to the right at its lower termination. In the letters A and M the left-hand up-and-down portion extends below the line and curves at its lower portion to the left. The letters D and L are ornamented by the flourishes below the letters curving to the right. In the letters M

and W the central portions of the letters are looped, as shown. In the symbol & the central portion extends below the line and curves to the right, and the dollar-mark is ornamented by the line extending from its upper portion below the line.

The character of the design is preserved in the figures and lower-case, the light flourishes characterizing the b, f, g, h, j, l, and y, and the lower terminations of the f, g, j, p, q, y, and z extending below the line.

Having now described my invention, I claim as new—

The design for a font of printing-type, as shown and described.
