The ornamental design for a bubble blowing pen cap, as shown and described.


**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a bubble blowing pen cap showing my new design in an exploded condition; FIG. 2 is a front elevational view of FIG. 1 with the bubble blowing pen cap in a stored position; FIG. 3 is a front elevational view with the cord removed for ease of illustration; FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view of FIG. 3; FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view of FIG. 3; and, FIG. 6 is a top plan view of FIG. 3.

The writing instrument depicted by means of broken lines in FIGS. 1 and 2 has been shown for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.










