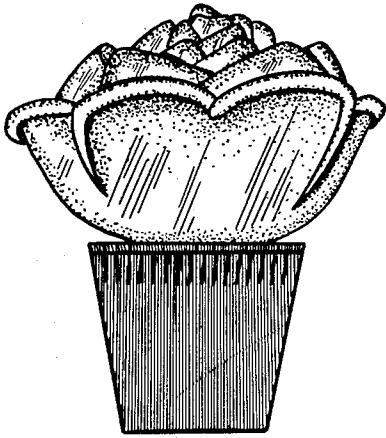

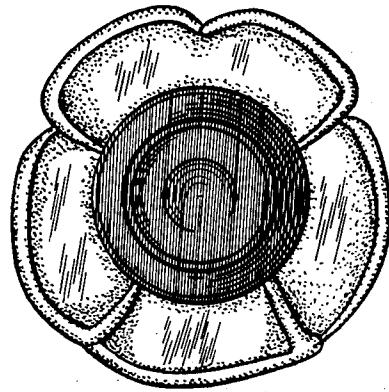

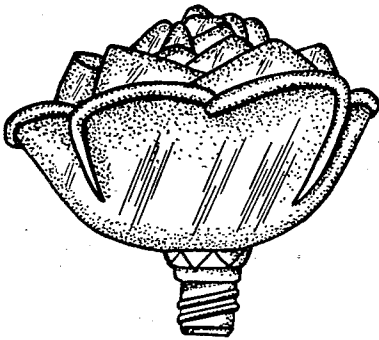

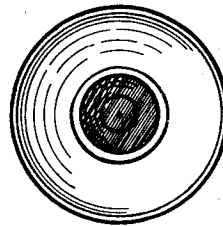

## DESIGN FOR A COMBINATION PERFUME BOTTLE AND STAND

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, Joseph Sudbeaz, a citizen of the United States of America, residing in Manhattan, county of New York, and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Combination Perfume Bottle and Stand, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof, wherein,

Figure 1 is an elevational view of a combination perfume bottle and stand, showing my new design.

Figure 2 is a bottom plan view of the combination perfume bottle and stand shown in Figure 1.

Figure 3 is an elevational view of the perfume bottle unit of the combination perfume bottle and stand.

Figure 4 is an inner plan view of the stand unit of the combination perfume bottle and stand.

The appearance of the combination perfume bottle and stand on all its sides is the same as appears in Figure 1 of the drawing.

I claim:

The ornamental design for a combination perfume bottle and stand, substantially as shown, and described.
