

## [57] CLAIM

I claim the ornamental design for a decorated window blinds, as shown and described.

## DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the decorated window blinds embodying the design of the present invention; FIG. 2 is an end elevational view thereof, the end opposite being a mirror image of the end shown in FIG. 2; FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof; FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof; and, FIG. 6 is a bottom view thereof.








