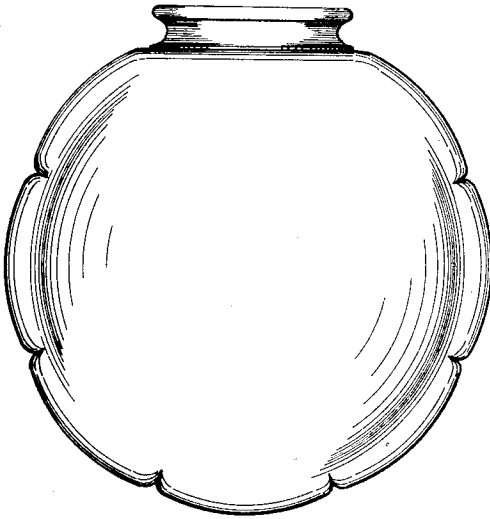

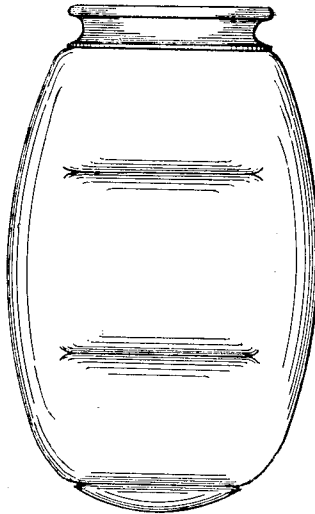

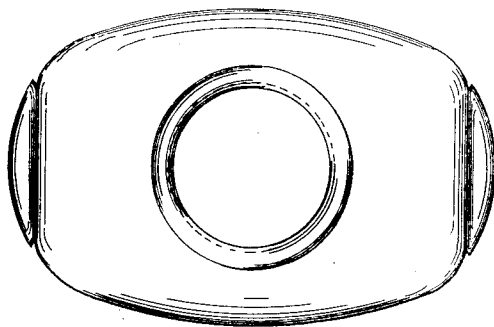

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, ALBERT GRAESER, a citizen of the United States of America, residing at 227 Orchard Place, Knoxville Borough, in the county of Allegheny and State of Pennsylvania, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for an Electric-Lamp Globe, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

Figure 1 is a front elevation, Fig. 2 a side elevation and Fig. 3 a plan of an electric lamp globe, showing my new design.
