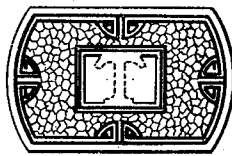
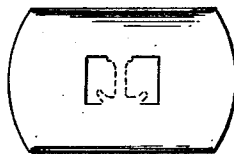

DESIGN FOR A BELT-BUCKLE FRAME.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, LOWELL W. SHIELDS, a citizen of the United States, residing at Rochester, in the county of Monroe and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Belt-Buckle Frame, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.
