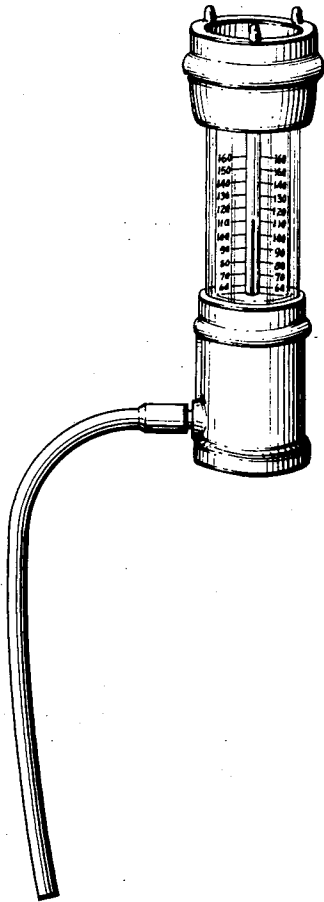

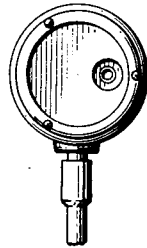

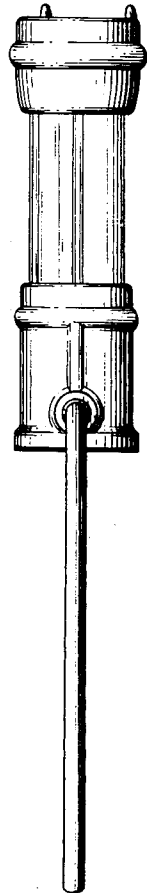

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, Leo Edelmann, a citizen of the United States, residing at Chicago, in the county of Cook and State of Illinois, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Nozzle End for a Thermohydrometer or the like, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing forming part thereof, and in which:

Figure 1 is a view in perspective of a nozzle end

for a thermohydrometer showing my new design.

Fig. 2 is a view in top plan.

Fig. 3 is a view in elevation taken substantially at right angles to the showing in Figure 1.
