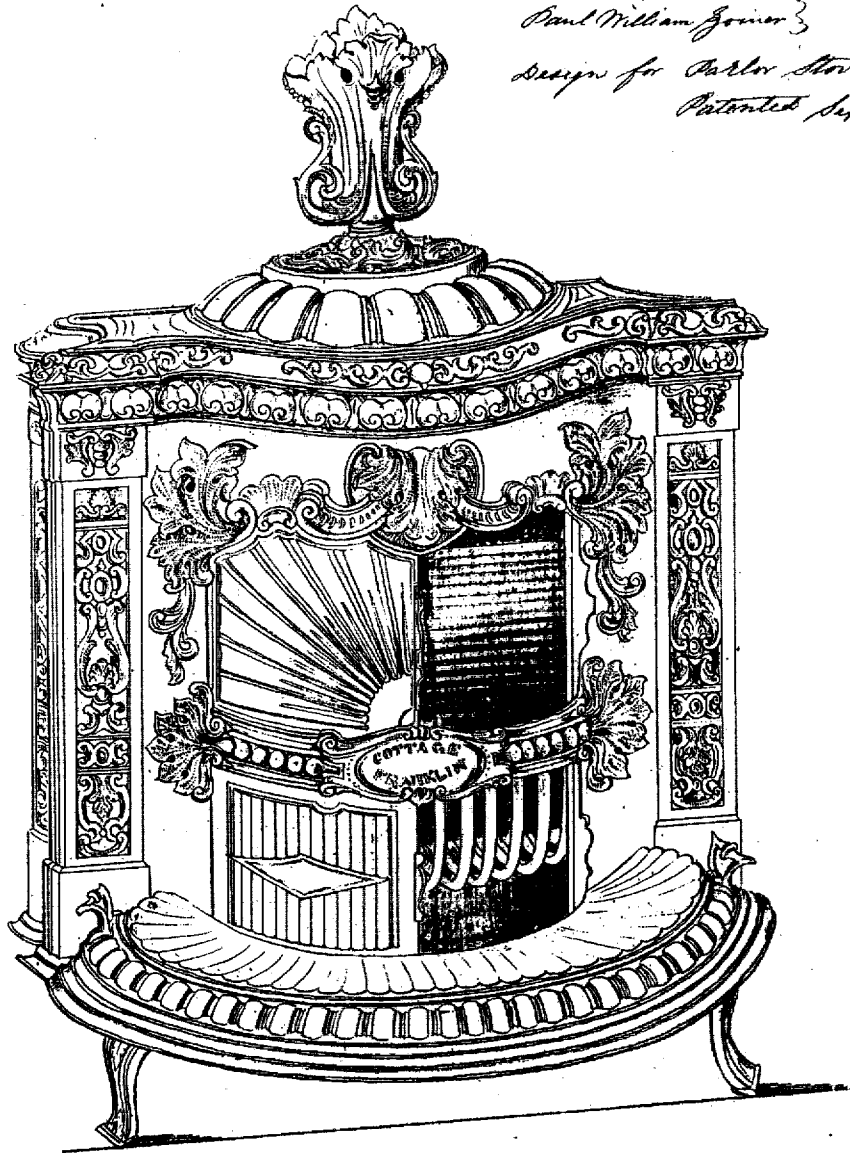

The schedule referred to in these Letters Patent and making part of the same

To whom it may concern:

Be it known that Conrad Harris & Paul W^m Joiner, both of Cincinnati, Hamilton County State of Ohio, have invented a new and useful design for parlor stoves, and we do hereby declare the following to be a full and exact description of the same to wit: Letter A, on the annexed drawing being a perspective view of the stove—

What we claim as our invention and desire to secure by Letters patent is the combination of the scrolls and foliage arranged as set forth in the annexed drawing, so as to form an ornamental design for Parlor Stoves to be known and called the "Cottage Franklin."
